5		A. The Stipulation benefits Frontier's customers and the public interest by
6		resolving all the issues raised within the Complaint, without engaging in litigation to
7		delay the timely implementation of the benefits to customers. The Stipulation provides a
8		guaranteed minimum capital expenditure for 2021-2023 along with 5 years of service
9		quality metrics, reporting and penalties for failing to meet metrics to ensure that
10		Frontier's telephone customers receive quality service. My prior testimony included a
11		typographical error in the last sentence.
12 13 14 15 16 17	Q17.	Could you describe the circumstances in the Stipulation where Frontier would be required to identify and commit an additional \$150,000 for missing a metric?  Pursuant to the Stipulation at Section IV.5.c, if Frontier has not met certain
18		metrics for two consecutive quarters, Frontier shall commit an additional \$150,000
19		in capital investment or operating expense for every year remaining in the term.
20		The metrics that subject Frontier to the additional capital investment or operating
21		expenses are identified in Sections 5.a.i, 5.a.ii, and 5.a.iii.
