portion of the Ohio to Erie Trail, parking lot expansions at Galena's Char Mar (which was called another popular park in the system) and Shale Hollow, and McCammon Creek stream restoration.

Departmental reports included updates on a new aviary and outdoor turtle enclosure at Deer Haven Park, ice cream making and hay production at Gallant Farm, reforestation at the new McCammon Creek, erosion repair at Emily Traphagen, construction at the new Hickory Woods, and design for a new shelter at Shale Hollow. It was also noted that a hickory tree fell on the district office at Hogback Ridge in Sunbury during a recent storm.

Finally, there was discussion about updating the Preservation Parks logo. The current logo is birds flying around two trees, and the new logo would be a fox with a

leaf-like tail. Volunteer Steve Berry said he felt the expense of implementing a new logo was unnecessary and trivial during a pandemic. Curtin said reaction to the new logo was "very positive."

The board did not take action on the logo, said a parks spokesperson. The decision was left to staff, who will pause to reflect

on the implementation of the logo.

best. And so I think that that's a big thing, too, is identifying your own self, and he's done a great job of that at a really young age."

Rahm held it together when he was four shots behind on the 13th hole Saturday. He birdied the next four holes for a 68, which he considered the best round of his career given the wind and the fast, crusty turf. So in a span of 15 holes — six to end the third round, the front nine on Sunday — Rahm went from a four-shot deficit to an eight-shot lead.

He is an explosive player, with or without a golf club in hand.

Rahm is the fifth youngest player to reach No. 1 in the world, trailing Tiger Woods in 1997, Jordan Spieth in 2015, Rory McIlroy in 2012 and Justin Thomas in 2018. Woods, Spieth and McIlroy had won majors by then, and that's the next step for Rahm.

For now, he is trying to process a lifetime ambition of being No. 1 in the world.

He recalled a conversation with his coach when he was in his early teens in Spain. The coach asked what he wanted to achieve.

overmatched at the big league level with a bat in their hands.

Not to mention legions of fans who'd much rather see a muscular DH taking dangerous cuts than an inexperienced starter flailing away or trying to sacrifice.

For them, the new rule is a welcome relief that saves some embarrassment.

"I don't have to punch out every time I go up there," Washington Nationals pitcher Austin Voth said.

Curiously, the push away from pitchers hitting comes at a progressive time when creative teams seem much more inclined to experiment with two-way players than in the past.

DH/starter Shohei Ohtani is the biggest such star with the Los Angeles Angels, of course. But there's also Brendan McKay in Tampa Bay, reliever/outfielder Michael Lorenzen in Cincinnati and more in the minor league pipeline.

If a guy is uber-talented enough to contribute both on the mound and in the lineup, some clubs don't want to stifle that spark and waste a potential opportunity anymore simply out of skepticism or fear of injury.

Babe Ruth, where have you been? "I'm going to miss it a lot," Miami Marlins pitcher Pablo López said. "I love taking batting practice and having that opportunity to be in the box and produce offensively. But it's going to give you more time to focus on your pitching."

Arrington was one of the most athletic linebackers in Big Ten history. He had three sacks in a 23-10 Penn State win over OSU in 1999 and 11 tackles and a sack in a 28-9 win by the Buckeyes in 1998.

Woodson is the only defensive player to win the Heisman and had a big impact all three times he played against Ohio State. In a 31-23 Michigan win in 1995 he had two interceptions. The next year he had nine tackles, two pass break-ups and a tackle for a loss

in a 13-9 Michigan win. In 1997, when Michigan won 20-14, he had an interception, returned a punt 78 yards for a touchdown and caught a pass for 37 yards.

Fletcher intercepted seven passes each of the three years he played at Wisconsin from 1998-2000 and was All-Big Ten three times and an All-American two years. He had an interception in 2000 in the only time he played against Ohio State.

Taylor had two interceptions against Ohio

State in the national championship game in 2002 and had 10 more for the Hurricanes in 2003. Dennard was the leader of Michigan State's 2013 secondary, which was called The No Fly Zone. That group was a big reason OSU lost to the Spartans in the 2013 Big Ten championship game.

Law had two interceptions in Michigan's 28-0 win over Ohio State in 1993 and 10 tackles in a 13-13 tie in 1992 before having a 15-year career in the NFL.

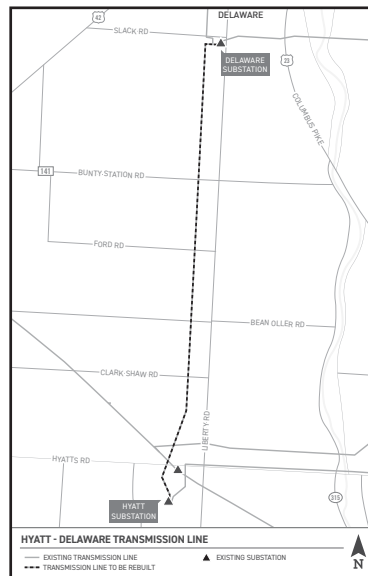

Pandemic proves deadly for nuns

LIVONIA, Michigan — At a convent near Detroit, 13 nuns have died of COVID-19. The toll is seven at a center for Maryknoll sisters in New York, and six at a Wisconsin convent that serves nuns with fading memories.

Each community perseveres, though strict social-distancing rules have made communal solidarity a challenge as the losses are mourned.

Only small, private funeral services were permitted as the death toll mounted in April and May at the Felician Sisters convent in Livonia, Michigan — a spiritual hardship for the surviving nuns.

"The yearnings, throughout the pandemic, were to be with our dying sisters and hold our traditional services, funeral Mass and burial, to comfort each other," said Sister Mary Christopher Moore, a leader of the Felician Sisters of North America.

For weeks the Livonia nuns went without Mass and dined in shifts, only one portable.

Those and other restrictions have eased in recent weeks as regular activities slowly resume.

But strict social-distancing rules remain in effect at the Our Lady of the Angels convent in Greenfield, Wisconsin, which provides memory care for nuns of the School Sisters of St. Francis and the School Sisters of Notre Dame.

Nearly all communal activities have been suspended since March, and the 40 remaining residents are not allowed to see visitors, said Michael O'Loughlin, communications director for the School Sisters of St. Francis.

"The changes are confusing for the sisters — the loss of their religious activities has been very difficult, with no Masses or daily Rosary in chapel," he said. "They do not understand the virus and find it difficult to stay confined to their rooms."

At the Maryknoll Sisters' center in Ossining, New York, as at the Greenfield convent, there have been no new coronavirus cases in recent weeks.

"Thank God things are stable," said a Maryknoll spokeswoman, Chelsea Lopez. She said 177 sisters are still residing there and abiding by health officials' recommended social-distancing protocols.

In several important respects, convents share some of the same health

vulnerabilities as nursing homes, the hardest-hit sector in the U.S. in terms of COVID-19 deaths. In many cases, their populations are elderly and live in close quarters with one another.

"We realize that our communal lifestyle makes us, along with other religious communities, a target for this virus," Sister Mary Christopher acknowledged in May.

In Livonia, some of the nuns who survived COVID-19 infections have continued to experience weakness and respiratory problems, according to Sister Mary Christopher. Though in-person Masses have resumed, some of the sisters continue to participate via closed-circuit television or other electronic devices.

The 13 deaths — more than 20% of the convent's population — have been a huge blow for the surrounding community, where the nuns played important roles. Those who died ranged in age from 69 to 99; they included a librarian, a nurse and several teachers.

The Felician Sisters "have been taking care of people in our community literally from cradle to grave," said Livonia Mayor Maureen Miller Brosnan. "Now we have less nuns that are available to work in the hospital, less nuns that are available in our teaching institutions, less nuns that are out there taking care of making sure our souls are protected."

Brosnan, who took over as mayor of the city of about 93,000 in January, cited the nuns' role in a school, a university, a

hospital, a home for retired clergy members and a hospice, all within walking distance of their Livonia compound.

"They're responsible for my education through grade school," she said. "They've educated my husband. They educated my three children. We put our hearts in their hands."

At Our Lady of the Angels in Wisconsin, the nuns who died in March and April had retired years ago. Some moved into the facility when it opened in 2011.

Among them were Sister Josephine Seier, 94, who had been with the School Sisters of St. Francis for 79 years, and Sister Mary Francele Sherburne, 99, who spent 34 years as an English professor at Mount Mary University.

The eldest was Sister Annelda Holtkamp, 102, who spent 33 years at St. Joseph's High School Convent in Kenosha, Wisconsin.

According to her order, Sister Annelda grew up with six siblings on a farm in St. Paul, Iowa, walking more than four miles each way to the Catholic school she attended.

In her 20s, she joined the School Sisters of St. Francis. Her first duties were working in a convent laundry facility. Her last assignment was at St. Mary's Convent in Chilton, Wisconsin, where, according to the order, she was known for her embroidery skills: "I could make almost anything," she said after winning ribbons at the county fair.

Milestone for ADA comes at tough time

The Americans With Disabilities Act was a major turning point in opening large parts of U.S. society to disabled people, but three decades after its passage disabled workers still face higher unemployment than other adults — a problem compounded by the coronavirus pandemic.

Sunday marks 30 years since the ADA was signed into law by President George H.W. Bush with wide bipartisan support. It prohibits discrimination against people with disabilities in areas such as employment, transportation and public accommodations.

In practice, that's meant everything from usable public bathrooms to seats in movie theaters and access to public schools.

"The historically dominant view was that it was an individual problem that each person or family had to cope with on their own," said Douglas Kruse, an economist at Rutgers University who began using a wheelchair after a drunken driver crashed into him in 1990. "The ADA represented a shift in perspective that a lot of the problems with disability are more societal and environmental."

When it comes to employment for the disabled, things were looking up in the booming June 2019 economy before the coronavirus hit. Still, the unemployment rate was nearly 8% even though a large majority said in surveys they can and want to work, Kruse said. Those who are employed often hold low-level jobs in industries like food service, home health care and janitorial work.

"Even 30 years after the ADA, there's still a lot of employer reluctance," Kruse said.

The situation has gotten worse during the pandemic. In June 2020, the unemployment rate for disabled people rose to 16.5%, compared with 11% for workers without a disability, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics said.

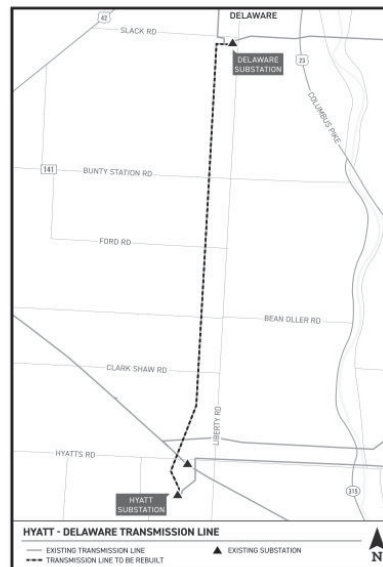

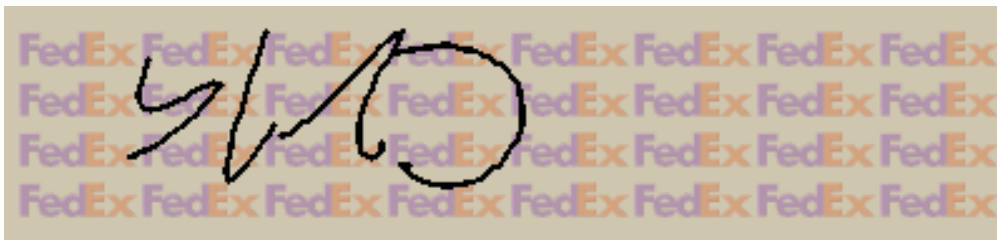
