{¶ 1} On July 20, 2020, Legend Energy Advisors, LLC (LEA) filed a renewal application, in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-24-05, for certification as an Ohio competitive retail electric aggregator/power broker, as defined in R.C. 4928.01.

{¶ 2} Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-24-10(A) provides that an application shall be deemed automatically approved pursuant to R.C. 4928.08 upon the 31st day after the official filing date. Further, Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-24-10(A) provides that, upon good cause shown, an attorney examiner may suspend its consideration of an application.

{¶ 3} The attorney examiner finds that, in order for the Commission and its Staff to further review this matter, LEA's application should be suspended until the Commission specifically orders otherwise.

{¶ 4} It is, therefore,

{¶ 5} ORDERED, That the automatic approval process for LEA's application be suspended. It is, further,
