SUMMARY

On July 20, 2020, in Case No. 20-1297-GA-AEC, Generation Pipeline LLC (Generation Pipeline) filed an application requesting approval for an amendment to a transportation service agreement (TSA) with IronUnits LLC (IronUnits).

The original agreement between Generation Pipeline and IronUnits was approved by the Commission in the Finding and Order dated December 18, 2019 in Case No. 19-1976-GA-AEC. On June 30, 2020 Generation Pipeline and IronUnits agreed to amend the original agreement, which include modifications to the contract commodity rate for the first five years of service, the commencement date for the contract rates, and the force majeure provision which includes limiting the allowed force majeure events.

STAFF REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION

Staff reviewed the application filed in the above case and finds the amendment to the TSA to be reasonable and recommends to the Commission that the application be approved.
