Realgy was a software services company specializing in the development of energy software and marketing tools for use by energy service companies, trading companies and marketers seeking to serve the emerging deregulated energy industry.



Realgy Energy Services is operated as a dba of Realgy and is organized to provide natural gas, electricity and energy services to customers. Realgy has operated as an energy marketer providing natural gas as follows:

- Indiana; authorized supplier of residential and commercial customers behind NIPSCO (Northern Indian Public Service Company) since April 2003 and Citizens Gas in May 2009
- Illinois; non-residential and non-small commercial customers' alternative gas supplier (AGS) since April 2004, behind Nicor Gas, Peoples Gas, and North Shore Gas. Realgy has been serving residential and small commercial since February 2012.
- Michigan; commercial, residential and industrial customers with Consumers, MichCon/DTE since April 2008, with SEMCO and Michigan Gas Utility since February 2011.

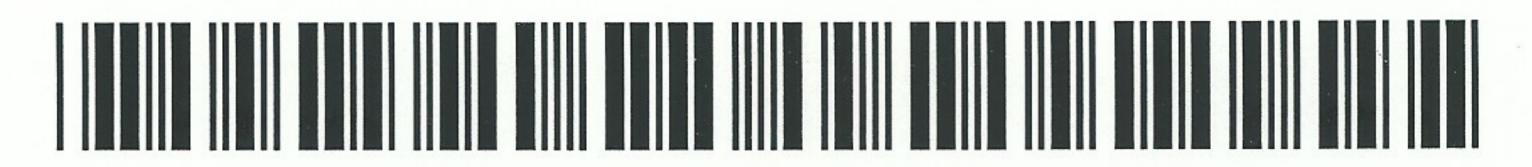

As documented within this Application, Realgy has experience as an energy marketer.

Our approach in entering a new utility market is as follows;

- 1. Model the utility tariffs to determine their costs structure and service requirements.
- 2. Review our wholesale purchase options and cost of service throughout the utility service area.
- 3. Create Realgy's service plan based on competing with the utility tariff structure and costs.
- 4. Create a pricing comparison between the utility and Realgy's service plan offering.

The above process results in a specific offering for use throughout the utility territory or specific offers to residential, commercial and industrial.

Realgy's sales plan includes direct agents, telemarketers, referral services and employees.

Realgy will use both recorded third party verification and paper contracts to enroll customers.

Realgy will supply natural gas (as it has since 2002) for our customers by purchasing wholesale supplies from various supplies then using our internal nomination and balancing personnel to arrange for deliveries to the various supply points.

Realgy prefers to utilize utility consolidated billing (UCB) where available and that would be the case in Ohio. Where UCB is not available, Realgy has experience providing supply-only invoices and we plan to provide that as needed in Ohio. Our invoices include service period dates, metered quantities, price, and monthly billing amounts. Additional information would be added to comply with Ohio requirements or provide additional detail.

Customer service is provided using online access to customer specific information, call center messaging, employee based customer service, agent directly and through online chat.

Realgy trains all sales and customer service employee and agents. Customer complaint resolution is a top priority. Customer service has discretion to resolve all matters within given parameters and they are encouraged to seek approval from management where circumstances warrant. Realgy always informs customers of their rights to file complaints with the utility and regulatory authority.

Realgy has reviewed the Commission's rules adopted pursuant to Section 4928.10 and 4929.22 of the Revised Code and will comply.

REALGY'S OPERATIONS

Realgy is a retail energy supplier in Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, and Ohio. We provide natural gas service in all four states and electric service in Illinois via the PJM Interconnection (PJM) and Midwest Independent System Operator (MISO) and Ohio.

In Ohio since our authorization, we have become certified by Duke Energy Ohio, AEP Ohio and First Energy. Our wholesale supply will be procured from the PJM day ahead and balancing (real-time) markets and we will use the PJM network integrated transmission service and ancillary services as required. We will schedule our load per the attendant utility and PJM protocols and comply with all state regulatory requirements and utility rules.

Realgy will not provide generation, but instead will procure it wholesale via PJM on behalf of our retail customers.

Realgy will pursue development of retail solar PV installation for use solely behind the meter (not for back feed into the grid).

REALGY'S OPERATIONS EXPERTISE

As described in this application Realgy has management practice in retail energy spanning 29+ years as of July 2020.

Realgy Energy Services is a private and independently owned energy services company and a retail marketer of natural gas and electricity. Realgy Energy Services has been providing natural gas services to customers as follows:

Illinois; non-residential and non-small commercial customers' alternative gas supplier (AGS) since April 2004 (ICC docket number 07-022 has been requested to be consolidated into Realgy application filed with ICC in February 2012 to include service to residential customer and North Shore Gas).
