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Exhibit D-1 **Operations**

Currently, the Industrial Energy Users-Ohio ("IEU-Ohio") aggregates its member's usage for the purpose of offering them as a demand response resource into PJM Interconnection LLC (PJM). For the members utilizing IEU-Ohio in this capacity IEU-Ohio submits an annual plan to PJM identifying the specific customer locations participating.

IEU-Ohio does not presently aggregate its member's usage for the purpose of arranging generation supply. However, IEU-Ohio wishes to retain the flexibility to do so in the future if member needs change.

Exhibit D-2
Operations Expertise and Key Technical Personnel

When PJM dispatches demand response resource it contacts IEU-Ohio both through notices posted on PJM's website and direct telephonic contact. An IEU-Ohio representative then sends dispatch instructions to individual customers primarily through telephonic means. Most customers provide multiple points of contact to ensure that dispatch instructions are received and followed.

After an event occurs IEU-Ohio representatives collect meter data from customers that were dispatched and submit this data to PJM for settlements.

Individuals assisting IEU-Ohio in these activities include:

Joseph Bowser, is a CPA by degree. Mr. Bowser has over thirty years of experience in the energy industry and has assisted customers participating in PJM demand response programs for approximately 20 years.

Kevin Murray, holds a metallurgical engineering degree. Mr. Murray has over 25 years of experience in the energy industry and has assisted customers participating in PJM demand response programs for approximately 20 years.

David Mabry, holds an electrical engineering degree. Mr. Mabry has over 25 years of experience in the energy industry and has assisted customers participating in PJM demand response programs for approximately 15 years. Prior to joining McNees Wallace and Nurick, Mr. Mabry served ten years with PJM Interconnection and seven years with the GPU companies where he focused primarily on day-ahead operations, real-time operations and post-event analysis of energy markets.
