Pursuant to the Ohio Administrative Code rule 4901:1-6-08, this is an Application for Certification (ACE). As such, this ACE application is subject to a 30-day approval process. The automatic approval date is September 25, with an effective date of September 26, 2020.

On August 26, 2020, Medina Fiber LLC DBA Medina Fiber (Applicant) filed an ACE application seeking authority to provide facilities-based competitive local exchange telecommunications services throughout the State of Ohio. The Applicant is proposing to offer basic local exchange service (BLES) bundled with other non-regulated services to residential and business customers.

This is an application seeking authority to offer a bundle or package of services as defined in 4927.01(A)(3), as such it must comply with §4901:1-6-08 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Upon review of the application, Staff found some deficiencies; as such Staff contacted the Applicant to request the application be revised to correct these deficiencies. The Applicant forwarded the requested corrections to staff on September 22, 2020. Upon review of those corrections, Staff found them to be sufficient.

The Staff reviewed all documents and exhibits filed on August 26 and as amended September 22, 2020. In conclusion, the Staff review found that the application, as amended, is reasonable. Therefore, Staff recommends that the Applicant's Application for Certification (ACE) be approved.
