Notice of Proposed Utility Facility

Atlanta Farms Solar Project, LLC, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Savion, LLC, is proposing to build the Atlanta Farms Solar Project, a solar-powered generation facility located in Deer Creek and Perry Townships, Pickaway County, Ohio. The facility will have a maximum total project generating capacity of up to 200 megawatts. The purpose of the facility is to generate electricity and its anticipated function is to supply renewable energy.

Atlanta Farms filed its application with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) for a certificate to construct, operate, and maintain the proposed facility in OPSB Case No. 19-1880-EL-BGN. A copy of the application is available on the OPSB website at <http://dis.puc.state.oh.us/CaseRecord.aspx?Caseno=19-1880&link=DIVA> and Atlanta Farms' website at www.atlantafarmsolarproject.com.

On August 31, 2020, the OPSB established the procedural schedule in this case. The first notice of the procedural schedule was published in the *Circleville Herald*, a newspaper of general circulation Pickaway County, Ohio on September 5, 2020.

The public will be given an opportunity to comment on the proposed facility. Due to the continued state of emergency, and given the passage of Am. Sub. H.B. 197, the local public and adjudicatory hearings will both be held using remote access technology that facilitate participation by telephone and/or live video on the internet. Therefore, the public hearing in Atlanta Farms' OPSB case shall consist of two parts and will use remote access technology that facilitates participation by telephone and/or live video on the internet:

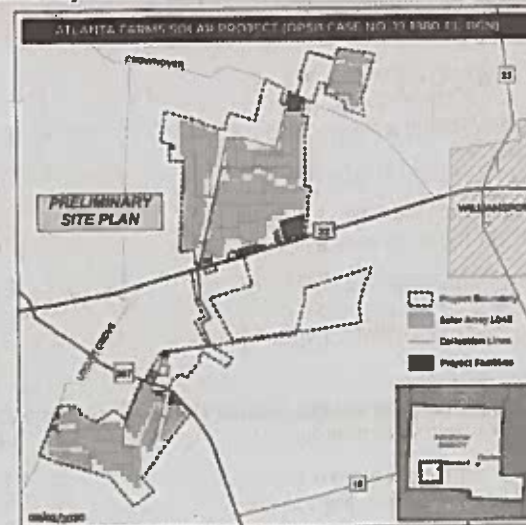
- (1) A local public hearing, pursuant to R.C. 4906.08(C), will be held on October 22, 2020, beginning at 6:00 p.m.
 - (a) Persons that wish to provide testimony regarding the project or that plan to join the remote access event must:
 - Register with the Consumer Call Center for the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) before 12:00 p.m. on October 21, 2020, by calling 1-800-686-7826 or by using the OPSB's online comment form at <https://opsb.ohio.gov/wps/portal/gov/opsb/events/Atlanta-farms-public-hearing>
 - Individuals who have registered to testify will be asked to speak beginning shortly after 6:00 p.m. All those registered to testify should be prepared to speak at that time.
 - If access or other issues are experienced during the local public hearing, individuals should immediately use the chat function within WebEx or contact the OPSB's legal department at 1-614-466-6843 for assistance.
 - (b) Interested individuals who wish to attend the public hearing remotely and not offer testimony can do so by calling +1-408-418-9388 and entering access code 173 031 1816. The local public hearing will also be live streamed for viewing at <https://www.youtube.com/user/PUCOhio>.
