{¶ 1} Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon A Clarkson's Logistic (Respondent) in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.

{¶ 2} On October 23, 2020, the Commission received a letter from Respondent requesting that Respondent's case be reopened. The Commission recognizes Respondent's correspondence as a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.

{¶ 3} As set forth in Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-16(B), unless otherwise ordered by the Commission or agreed by the parties, a prehearing conference in a civil forfeiture case shall be scheduled upon the filing of a request for administrative hearing.

{¶ 4} The parties in this case are directed to participate in a prehearing teleconference on December 8, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. At that time, the attorney examiner will attempt to contact the Respondent by telephone.
