REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION SUBMITTED ON BEHALF OF THE STAFF OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF OHIO

On November 10, 2020 Advanced Integrated Technologies, Inc (Applicant) filed an application to abandon all telecommunications services and relinquish its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN), 90-9271, pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-6-26. The Applicant received certification as a competitive local exchange carrier (CLEC) in the state of Ohio on October 11, 2003, under case number 03-1923-TP-ACE. The Applicant offered resold local exchange and long-distance services to business customers.

The Applicant is relinquishing its CPCN because its owner is deceased, and the business is being closed. In 2019 all business customers were transitioned to other carriers. Customer notices were unnecessary for this application since the Applicant has not offered services in Ohio since 2019.

Additionally, the Applicant has complied with all reporting requirements by filing its Telecommunications Relay Service report and annual assessment report on March 17, 2020, including paying all outstanding invoices.

This application is being filed pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-6-26. Absent full or partial suspension, an application in which a company is abandoning operations is approved in accordance with the thirty-day automatic approval process set forth in Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-6-05. Staff recommends approval of this application on December 10, 2020. Moreover, Staff will cancel Certificate No. 90-9271 and the associated TRF docket within ten business days after Commission approval.
