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ALJ DAVIS: We are going to go on the record.

So the Ohio Power Siting Board has set for hearing at this time and place Case No. 20-1288-EL-BGN which is captioned in the Matter of the Application of Hecate Energy Highland 4 LLC for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need.

So as Judge Williams said, good morning. Welcome aboard. My name is Jesse Davis, and with me is Michael Williams. We are the Administrative Law Judges in the Legal Department of the Ohio Power Siting Board, and we have been assigned by the Board to this proceeding which is Case No. 20-1288-EL-BGN.

At this time we will take appearances from the parties, on behalf of the Applicant, the Ohio Farm Bureau Federation, and Board Staff.

MS. WINTERS: Appearing this morning on behalf of the Applicant Hecate Energy Highland 4 LLC is Karen Winters with the law firm of Squire Patton Boggs, and I will allow my co-counsel to introduce herself as well.

MS. GAGLIARDI: Yes. On behalf of the Applicant Hecate Energy Highland 4 LLC, appearing is Danielle Gagliardi at Squire Patton Boggs.

ALJ WILLIAMS: On behalf of the Farm Bureau.

MS. MILAM: Good morning, your Honor.

ALJ WILLIAMS: Thank you, Ms. Milam.

MR. LINDGREN: Thank you, your Honor. On behalf of the Board Staff, Ohio Attorney General Dave Yost by Thomas Lindgren and Robert Eubanks, Assistant Attorney General, 30 East Broad Street, 26th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

ALJ DAVIS: Thank you, counsel, and thank you, Judge Williams.

I would point out this adjudicatory
hearing is taking place pursuant to the parameters
set forth in the entry of November 18. And, of
course, due to the COVID-19 emergency that remains in
effect under Executive Order 2020-01D which was
issued by the Governor, today's hearing is being held
through Webex which enables interested parties to
offer testimony on the proposed project by telephone

or via internet; and, of course, this is how we will receive witness testimony today.

Before we get started with the first witness, I just want to address some preliminary issues. So, first, if counsel or witnesses are having any technical difficulties during the hearing, please immediately let us know. You can contact the host via the Webex chat function in the Webex window, or you can call (614) 466-6843. Please be advised that chats are recorded and should not be considered private, and chats are not part of the official record of the case and that function should strictly be used for technical or process questions.

point, you can try to join Webex again via video, or you can call in. If these options are unsuccessful, you can call the Legal Division of the Board at (614) 466-6843 for assistance. More information about Webex, the technical option -- help options can be obtained through the chat feature, you know, which is going to be available throughout the hearing. You may click on the chat button at any time to obtain technical assistance or ask procedural questions. Again, the chat feature is not really to be used for any other purpose, just for technical assistance, and

the chats are not private.

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So how the hearing is going to be conducted today we will proceed in the same way as an in person hearing occurs before the Board. However, due to the remote nature of the hearing, I just wanted to set the ground rules and reminders. To avoid unnecessary background noise, I just want to ask counsel to keep their microphones on mute unless they are speaking or to be prepared to speak as quickly as possible in the case of raising objections during cross of a witness.

With respect to video, counsel should have their cameras on at all times except during breaks. You can also turn your video off if you need to step away from the hearing if your co-counsel is taking lead. Just remember that when you return, please turn your camera back on. Witnesses will need to turn their cameras and microphones on when it's their turn to testify.

And, of course, probably primarily, please be mindful of the court reporter. This is very important. You should speak clearly and at a reasonable speed so that the court reporter can accurately transcribe the hearing. And as a reminder, everyone should do their best to avoid

With the preliminaries on the record, I am going to hand it over to Judge Williams to begin the hearing with the presentation of our first witness.

We took a few preliminary matters off the record, and we will go ahead and make sure those are captured as part of the transcript today. So the issues involved the filing or recognition by the Board of confidential Exhibit 23 as well as additional documents that were filed in the docket I believe late Friday or maybe even over the weekend to include a Supplemental Joint Stipulation as well as some supplemental testimony from Witness Shorr.

Ms. Winters and I and the parties all discussed collectively off the record that confidential Exhibit 23 should be identified and moved for admission, and we will consider the issues regarding its admissibility. If it is admitted, it will be admitted subject to the protective order already outlined by the Attorney Examiners in this case.

And we did also note that the 1 2 Supplemental Joint Stipulation as well as the 3 supplemental testimony from Ms. Shorr will be part of the docket, do not need to be separately filed. 4 5 So those were the preliminary matters we 6 discussed off the record. Anything else from the 7 parties before we proceed with the first witness? 8 Seeing none, Ms. Winters, please proceed. 9 MS. WINTERS: Okay. I would like to call 10 Patricia Shorr as my first witness. 11 MR. SCHMIDT: Ms. Shorr, you have been 12 promoted to the role of panelist. If you could 13 unmute your audio and enable your video. 14 MS. SHORR: I think I've done that. 15 ALJ WILLIAMS: Good morning, Ms. Shorr. 16 MS. being first duly sworn, as prescribed by law, was examined and testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

5 By Ms. Winters:

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- Q. Could you please state your name, title, and the company you work for for the record, please.
- A. Yes. My name is Patti Shorr. I am the Vice President, Project Development, for Hecate Energy LLC located at 621 West Randolph Street, Chicago, Illinois 60661.
- Q. Ms. Shorr, I am going to direct your attention to what we've marked in the documents previously circulated to both counsel in this case as well as the Judges and yourself Exhibit 21, your initial direct testimony. Can you take -- do you have that in front of you?
 - A. I do.
- Q. Can you confirm that that is your testimony that was filed with the Board on January 22, 2021?
 - A. Yes, that is. I confirm it.
- Q. Can you confirm that the testimony was prepared under your supervision and direction?
- 25 A. I confirm that.

- Q. As well as that it's a true and accurate copy of what was filed with the Board?
 - A. I confirm that as well.

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- Q. Do you have any corrections to your testimony since its filing on January 22, 2021?
 - A. I do not have any corrections.
- Q. If you were asked the same questions that are currently set forth in that Applicant's Exhibit No. 21, would your answers be the same?
 - A. Yes, my answers would be the same.
- Q. Okay. Next, I am going to direct your attention to what's been marked as Exhibit 24 in that same set of materials that were circulated electronically to counsel, the Judges in this case, and yourself and ask if you can identify that supplemental direct testimony.
- A. Yes, I can identify the supplemental direct testimony.
- Q. And that was filed with the Board earlier today in the proceeding?
 - A. That's correct.
- Q. Can you confirm that the supplemental testimony was prepared under your supervision and direction and that it's a true and accurate copy -- copy of that testimony?

- A. I can confirm that it was prepared under my supervision and that it is filed correctly.
- Q. Okay. Do you have any corrections to your supplemental testimony?
 - A. I do not.

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- Q. Okay. Next, I am going to turn your attention to what's been marked as Exhibit 23, the unredacted portions of the application that were filed with the clerk's office previously in the case. Can you identify that document for us.
 - A. I can.
- Q. Is it a true and accurate copy of the unredacted portions of the application that were filed previously in the case?
 - A. It is.
- Q. Okay. Should these unredacted portions of the application continue to remain confidential?
 - A. I think they should.
- MS. WINTERS: Okay. Your Honor, I have no further questions for this witness. She's certainly available for cross-examination, after which I will move the exhibits that she identifies in her testimony, her written testimony, into evidence.

will look and see if anyone has any. I see no one reaching for their microphones or frantically waving.

By ALJ Williams:

- Q. In terms of the commitments made by the Applicant, the commitments are unchanged from the application in regard to what would be a bifurcated certification amongst the Hecate 2 and Hecate 4, correct?
 - A. That is correct, your Honor.

ALJ WILLIAMS: Okay. Those are the only questions I have.

Ms. Winters, why don't we go ahead and identify your exhibits and move for their admission before we let the witness go, if that's okay.

MS. WINTERS: Okay. In terms of
