{¶ 1} Staff has served a notice of preliminary determination upon Secure Transport, LLC, in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.

{¶ 2} On December 30, 2020, Secure Transport, LLC, requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.

{¶ 3} In an Entry issued January 5, 2021, a prehearing conference was scheduled for January 26, 2021. However, Staff was unable to contact Secure Transport, LLC, on January 26, 2021.
