The Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) will hold a virtual public hearing for the Emerson Creek Transmission Line, # 19-1073-ELBTX, on Feb 9, 2021.

I am confident that the OPSB clearly realizes that the more than 1,000 public letters, comments, and signed petitions in opposition to the Emerson Creek Wind Project from the people in Erie and Huron Counties make it obvious that we would also oppose the Transmission Line project. Without the Emerson Creek Wind Project, there is no need for a Transmission Line Project.
