The permittee is authorized to exit the permitted route at any State Highway intersection for food, fuel, rest, or repair provided that the hauler does not travel more than 5,280 feet (1 mile) from the interchange (measured as a lane mile from the junction of the off ramp) and does not cross under (if permitted height exceeds 13 feet 6 inches) or over any structure (structure is defined as anything 10 feet wide or greater). When re-entering the permitted route, the permittee must abide by the same restrictions as when exiting the permitted route. By traveling more than 5,280 feet (1 mile) or crossing over or under (if permitted height exceeds 13 feet 6 inches) any structure the permittee will be considered off route. In the event that the permittee travels beyond the one mile limit, crosses a structure within one mile variance or violates any other provision of the permit, the permittee is in violation and subject to applicable fines and penalties. The permittee should have the ability to see the facility where they are stopping from the permitted route. ODOT recommends that the permittee familiarize themselves with the various exits and entrances they may choose. Permission to travel county or township roads, local streets not part of the State Route, or the Ohio Turnpike must be obtained from the proper authorities. All Permitted Loads Must Stop At All Weigh Stations Regardless of In-Cab Transponder Signal.

THIS LOAD MAY BE SUBJECT TO INSPECTION BY AN OSHP MOTOR CARRIER ENFORCEMENT INSPECTOR PRIOR TO ANY SUBSTANTIAL MOVEMENT.

If OSHP escorts are required they are in addition to the private escorts as required on Form OS-1A. If ODOT personnel are required, they will advise you of the location of any applicable structures on the assigned route which require conditional crossing. If the OSHP is required, they will assure compliance with the permit and provide traffic control at structures requiring restricted crossing. The permittee is responsible for payment of OSHP fees in accordance with their instructions. The vehicle/load must enter the first available weight station for weight and size verification. Prior to substantial movement the vehicle/load must stop at a location determined by ODOT and/or the OSHP for permit verification (measurements, license, etc.).

The permit vehicle may not exceed 55 M.P.H. over any structure on the assigned route, in addition to any individually identified structure crossing restrictions. If structures are listed as vehicle only on the following pages then the maximum speed is 40 M.P.H. unless otherwise defined. Movement of all loads vehicles/loads in excess of twelve feet in width shall be prohibited within Butler, Clermont, Cuyahoga, Delaware, Fairfield, Franklin, Geauga, Hamilton, Lake, Licking, Lorain, Lucas, Madison, Mahoning, Medina, Montgomery, Pickaway, Stark, Summit, Union, Warren and Wood Counties between the hours of 6:30 am to 9:00 am and 4:30 pm to 6:00 pm Monday through Friday unless otherwise specified by the Special Hauling Permit Section.

Movement must commence within ONE HOUR of the scheduled departure time if ODOT personnel are standing by. Otherwise, move will be postponed to a later scheduled date. Permittee shall remain responsible to pay expenses incurred by the State of Ohio personnel for the aborted move.

Special limitations listed are in addition to Limitations and applicable Special Provisions as noted on Special Hauling Permit attachment OS-1A. All convoy members must have same radio communication devices capable of speaking and hearing all other members of the same convoy.

Towing vehicle must be of sufficient power to maintain minimum highway speeds. Variable load or lift axles, when listed as load bearing axles on the permit, must remain in the fully lowered position except during turning maneuvers where there would be excessive tire and pavement scuffing or control of the vehicle would be hindered. Controls for these axles may be located inside the cab of the towing vehicle.

When not performing tiller operations, tiller operator must ride with a convoy member and not operate any other vehicle. The hauler is responsible for notifying any affected local authorities of movement to determine if any conditions exist which may impede safe and clear movement.

County or township roads or city streets not part of the state highway system may be included as connectors between state highways, however, permission to use these routes must be obtained from the proper authorities. Locations of restricted structures requiring conditional crossing (if any) are listed on the following page (s). All restrictions pertaining to the ODOT Special Hauling Permit only pertain to the vehicle while it is on the State Designated Highway, once the permitted vehicle leaves the State System the local permit conditions must be followed along with any escorting requirements associated with the local permit. Do not deviate from this route, even to exit for fuel, as you may cross unanalyzed structures and cause damage.

Maximum permitted speed may not exceed 55 mph.

The Human Trafficking page of this permit is not a part of the valid permit and as such enforcement should not be taken for not having that page. All other requirements remain.

## **Be an Everyday Hero! Help end human trafficking!**

Slavery has been illegal for centuries, but **human trafficking has created more slaves today than ever before**. It's happening to our own children in all 50 states and DC, along most of our highways in locations including truck stops, motels/hotels, strip clubs, private homes, rest areas, etc. Traffickers control their victims through force, fraud and coercion. **Any minor engaged in commercial sex is a victim of human trafficking**. If you see a minor working, any of these areas or suspect the person selling sex is under someone's control to make a quota, **make a call and save lives**.

call 911 and the National Human Trafficking Hotline at 1-888-3737-888 (US)  
or text INFO or HELP to BeFree (233733)**

Calls to the hotline can be anonymous. Provide descriptions of cars and people involved, specific times and dates, addresses and locations where the suspicious activity took place.

### **Red Flags to look for:**

- Does the victim know her/his whereabouts and have control of own ID/passport?
- Is there restricted or controlled communication – victim not allowed to speak for self?
- Have you heard CB chatter about “commercial company” or flashing light signaling “buyer” location?
- Is there acknowledgment of a pimp and making a quota?
- Are there signs of branding or tattooing of a trafficker's name (often on the neck)?
- Does a van or RV seem out of place back by trucks; a vehicle dropping someone off at a truck and returning 15-20 minutes later for a pick-up of a person?

### **Remember:**

Don't approach traffickers. Allow law enforcement to deal with traffickers and recover victims. Approaching traffickers is dangerous for you and the victims. Also, anyone using their CMV to commit to a felony involving a severe form of human trafficking will receive a lifetime CDL ban. All 50 states and DC have a law criminalizing sex trafficking. Some states punish purchasers the same as sex traffickers, and 31 states have a buyer applicable trafficking law prohibiting mistake-of-age defense in prosecutions for buying commercial sex act with any minor under 18.
