If you can enable your audio and video. 2.2 MR. TORNAIN: Good morning. 23 EXAMINER DAVIS: Good morning. Good 24 morning. Thank you for being here. If you could 25 raise your right hand.

9 (Witness sworn.) 1 2 EXAMINER DAVIS: Thank you. You may 3 proceed, counsel. 4 5 TORNAIN MATTHEWS 6 being first duly sworn, as prescribed by law, was 7 examined and testified as follows: DIRECT EXAMINATION 8 9 By Ms. Kern: 10 Q. Good morning, Mr. Matthews. 11 Good morning. Α. 12 Q. Can you hear me? 13 A. Yes, I can. 14 Okay. Can you please state your name and Q. 15 by whom you are employed. 16 Yes. My name is Tornain and that's Α. 17 spelled T-O-R-N-A-I-N and last name is Matthews, 18 M-A-T-T-H-E-W-S; and I'm employed by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio. 19 20 Ο. Thank you. If you possibly -- oh, excuse 2.1 me. Do you have the Staff exhibits that I just had 2.2 marked as Staff Exhibits 1 and 2? They were the 23 audit reports. 24 Yes, ma'am, I do. Α.

responsibility for those documents that have been marked Staff Exhibits 1 and 2?

- A. Yes, ma'am, I did. I was responsible for the financial audit of the gas cost recovery mechanism. Also I was on the team that also reviewed the UEX portion of that as well.
- Q. Have you reviewed those documents prior to testifying today?
 - A. Yes, ma'am, I have.

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- Q. And are there any changes, corrections, amendments, modifications of any kind to the Staff Reports that you would like to make?
- A. There are no changes that I am aware of that we would like to make.
 - Q. And are they true and accurate and reasonable to the best of your belief and knowledge?
 - A. Yes, they are.
- Q. And, Mr. Matthews, you also have before you what has been marked as Joint Exhibit 1 and that is the Stipulation and Recommendation filed in these proceedings?
- A. Yes, ma'am, I do.
- Q. And were you involved in the negotiation of this Stipulation and Recommendation?
 - A. Yes, I was.

- Q. And in your opinion, were the parties involved in the negotiation of the settlement for this case knowledgeable about the issues that were settled therein?
 - A. Yes, they are -- they were, yes.
- Q. And do you believe there are any benefits, any public benefits to ratepayers as a result of this Stipulation?
 - A. Yes, yes, ma'am, I do.

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- Q. And the Stipulation and Recommendation, is that the Staff's findings, conclusions, and recommendations as contained in Staff Exhibits No. 1 and 2; is that correct?
 - A. Yes, that's correct.
- Q. Are you aware of any regulatory principle or practice that is violated by the Stipulation and Recommendation?
 - A. No, ma'am, none that I am aware of.

- Your Honor, I have no further questions for Mr. Matthews, and I would respectfully move for the admission of Staff Exhibits 1 and 2 and Joint Exhibit 1.

So Staff conducts these 15 audits in order to verify the costs that the Company incurs to provide natural gas service to its 16 17 customers. In addition to that, we verify that those 18 costs are properly reflected in rates that it bills 19 to its customers. 20 During the course of these audits, Staff 2.1 did find some minor differences and recommended 22 adjustments to correct those differences and those 23 are -- those are reflected in the Stipulation between

Waterville and the Staff.

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that the Stipulation is an efficient way to address the minor changes that Staff discovered during its audit of Waterville?

A. Yes, your Honor. I believe so, yes. EXAMINER SEE: Okay. Thank you,

Mr. Matthews.
