

The latest filing from Republic Wind is nothing more than more of the same fraud we have all come to expect with them. Most if not all of the their comments that are in "support" of the project have the following in common:

- They are form letters all of which are the same word for word
- When a John Doe submits a comment to Republic Wind or Emerson Creek Wind the exact same comment gets submitted to the other project
- Most of them are from 10+ miles outside the project area

So how does this happen you may ask? Is there really just that much support for the project 10+ miles outside of the project area? Here are some very important details on where these "comments" come from. APEX realized that early on their Republic Wind project was wildly unpopular locally and they were going to have to pull a rabbit out of the hat to make the OPSB believe there truly was substantial support for the project. With deep pockets and hundreds of employees APEX they devised a plan to stuff the ballot box if you will. They paid some big bucks to start a targeted Facebook ad campaign. This ad campaign uses Facebook ads to get people from all over Ohio (some outside of Ohio) to click on ad which takes them to a form to submit a comment of "support". These ads usually feature a beautiful picture of a Mother or Father with a young child with a beautiful sunset and one peaceful turbine way off in the distance. These ads say buzz words/phrases like: Help farmers, money for schools, millions of dollars of new tax revenue for better schools, roads, first responders, and communities. I think they even say they save starving puppies too (sarcasm here).

Let's talk about what they DON'T say: they don't even mention the words Republic Wind Project a project number or anything that talks about the specific project. They don't mention the county, the townships, the height of the wind turbines, the amount of wind turbines, the MWs, etc...

Then once the Ohioan clicks the picture, the link or the button it takes them to a form that is so simple to fill out and hit submit (see attachment). Again no mention of the project, etc.... After the person hits submit that is when the magic happens. Apex has this fancy expensive program that then auto generates a "public comment" for this unsuspecting Ohioan and submits it directly to the OPSB to be filed in not only the Republic Wind Project but also the Emerson Creek Wind project where it is pointed to as "support" for their project. The Ohioan has no clue what they have done and I can almost guarantee if you called up these people they would have no clue that what they truly signed up to support. In fact I personally have contacted some of these individuals and asked them and they were clueless.

I have attached different things here that show just how this scam is pulled off - How much money it costs to run the targeted Facebook ads, what the ads look like, what the form letter website looks like once you click the ad.

These form letters are a scam and should all be tossed aside and discredited. Less than 10% of all the comments of "support" are from people within the area and are not form letters. Then of that 10% almost all of those people are either leaseholders or good neighbor agreement holders. When you look at the comments in opposition they are from people from within or near the project area and are genuine heartfelt comments that took time and effort to come up with. These fake form letters of "support" MUST NOT be allowed to be purported to be any indication of the "support" for this ill sited Republic Wind Project. APEX has swung and missed with this and is yet another black eye for their PR team. If this is their best argument they should just pack up their bags and move on.

Also FYI these form letter ad campaigns go back to at least April of 2019

It does NOT mention anywhere that you are doing just that though. NO mention of either project at all.

- 7. PDF showing when APEX Republic Wind really amped up their Facebook ad dollars and got a whole slew of letters of "support" submitted at once

This most recent filling from Republic Wind needs to be stricken from the record immediately.
