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**MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF

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Pursuant to R.C. 4903.221 and Ohio Adm. Code 4901-01-11, the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission") should grant the Ohio Energy Group ("OEG") leave to intervene in this proceeding.

OEG is a non-profit entity organized to represent the interests of large industrial customers in electric and gas regulatory proceedings before the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission").
