{¶ 1} Staff has served a notice of preliminary determination upon Lakeside Transportation, Inc. in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.

{¶ 2} On November 6, 2020, the safety director for Lakeside Transportation, Inc. requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.

{¶ 3} An Entry was issued March 3, 2021, directing the parties to participate in a March 11, 2021 settlement conference. The parties participated as scheduled but a settlement was not reached.

{¶ 4} On September 15, 2021, counsel for Lakeside Transportation contacted the attorney examiner with a request to discuss the case. A prehearing conference was scheduled for October 7, 2021, but prior to that date was continued at the request of Lakeside's counsel. A subsequent prehearing conference that was scheduled for November 19, 2021, was postponed because of a conflict for the attorney examiner.

{¶ 5} Accordingly, the parties are directed to participate in a prehearing conference at 10:00 a.m. on December 3, 2021. At that time, Commission Staff will attempt to contact counsel for Lakeside Transportation by telephone.

{¶ 6} It is, therefore,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That a prehearing conference be conducted by telephone as indicated in Paragraph 5. It is, further,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
