before Daniel E. Fullin, Administrative Law Judge, via Webex Teleconference, called at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, October 28, 2021.

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Thursday Morning Session, October 28, 2021.

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ALJ FULLIN: I will get us started here.

Hello, I'm Dan Fullin. I'm the Administrative Law

Judge that's been assigned to this case, and I think

I'll just get started. I'm going through a few

preliminaries here, but we'll be underway soon.

The Ohio Power Siting Board has called for hearing at this time and place Case No. 21-36-EL-BGN which is the Matter of the Application of Marion County Solar Project, LLC for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need to Construct a Solar-Powered Electric Generation Facility in Marion County.

Again, my name is Daniel E. Fullin, spelled F-U-L-L-I-N, and I'm the Administrative Law Judge assigned to the case. I would now like to have appearances on behalf of the Applicant and then followed by any other parties and the Staff. We'll begin with the Applicant.

MR. McDONNELL: Thank you, your Honor.

On behalf of the Applicant Marion County Solar

Project, LLC, the law firm of Dickinson Wright by

Christine Pirik and Matthew McDonnell at 150 East Gay

Street, Suite 2400, Columbus, Ohio, 43215.

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ALJ FULLIN: Thank you.

And next let's have the appearance on behalf of the intervener in this case, the Farm Bureau.

MS. MILAM: Good morning, your Honor, Amy Milam on behalf of Ohio Farm Bureau Federation, 280 North High Street, 6th floor, Columbus, Ohio, 43215.

ALJ FULLIN: Thank you.

And on behalf of the Staff.

MR. LINDGREN: Thank you, your Honor. On behalf of the Board Staff, Ohio Attorney General Dave Yost by Thomas G. Lindgren, Assistant Attorney General at 30 East Broad Street, 26th floor, Columbus, Ohio, 43215.

ALJ FULLIN: Thank you.

I would note for the record that there are no other interveners, so I believe we have all the parties that we're expecting to participate in today's hearing online and they've all entered appearances.

So just a few little preliminary matters. This might be already familiar to people that have done these virtual hearings, probably some have done them more often than I have, first, if anyone

experiences technical difficulties, there are a couple of different options to address these.

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You can just speak up if you're able to reach me, you know, if I can hear you over the system or you could always call Micah, our event host, by calling 614-466-6843, or you could use the Chat function on the right-hand side of the Webex app, or you can chat with Micah or the bench to try to address any issues that you have.

Regarding the Chat, the Chats are recorded but are considered private, so they'll be able to be seen by the others, but they are not part of the official record for the case. If all else fails, again, just try to contact me if you need to by calling my cell number which is 614-378-5742.

I'll point out that anyone that happens to be watching or listening as attendees, you'll be able to observe the hearing but your microphones and video will remain muted and turned off. Witnesses are currently attendees, but when the time comes for them to testify, they will be promoted by our host to be participants in the hearing.

Let me see what else I need to cover. We ask that the counsel for all sides leave their cameras on at all times except during breaks which I

don't expect to have any. I don't expect this hearing to last that long. You can turn off your video if you have co-counsel stepping in. Looks like that's not going to happen today.

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I ask that everyone be mindful of the court reporter. Try to speak clearly and at a reasonable pace so the reporter can actually transcribe the testimony.

The exhibits that will be admitted in the record that have not previously been filed in this docket will need to be e-mailed to our court reporter. I don't expect that's going to happen. I believe everything that's going to be submitted as an exhibit has already been filed, but if that comes up later, just bring it to my attention.

I think that's all I have in terms of preliminary matters. With that, I'll go ahead and turn it over to Mr. McDonnell and he can call his first witness.

MR. McDONNELL: Thank you, your Honor. Would it be okay if we mark the exhibits for the record? Is that okay with you?

ALJ FULLIN: Yes, I'm anxious to do that.

MR. McDONNELL: Thank you, sir, much appreciated. At this time, we would like to mark the

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following documents, Joint Exhibit 1 which is the Joint Stipulation and Recommendation that was filed on October 13th, 2021.

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Applicant Exhibit 1 is the application which was filed on March 5th, 2021.

Applicant Exhibit 2 is the supplement to the application which was filed on March 31st, 2021.

Applicant Exhibit 3 is the response to the first data request which was filed on April 20th, 2021.

Applicant Exhibit 4 is the response to the second data request filed on April 27th, 2021.

Applicant Exhibit 5 is the supplemental response to the first data request filed on June 29th, 2021.

Applicant Exhibit 6 is the Response to the Third Data Request filed on July 6th, 2021.

Applicant Exhibit 7 is the Supplemental Response to the Third Data Request which was filed on July 23rd, 2021.

Applicant Exhibit 8 is the Response to the Fourth Data Request which was filed on August 23rd, 2021.

Applicant Exhibit 9 is the Certificate of Service of the Public Information Meetings that

was filed on February 4th, 2021.

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Applicant Exhibit 10 is the Proof of Publication of the Public Information Meeting that was filed on February 5th, 2021.

Applicant Exhibit 11 is a Certificate of Service for the Application filed on May 6th of 2021.

Applicant Exhibit 12 is the Proof of Service Publication that was filed on August 24th, 2021.

Applicant Exhibit 13 is the Proof of Service and Proof of Second Publication filed on September 23rd, 2021.

And Applicant Exhibit 14 is the Prefiled Testimony of Sean Flannery which was filed on October 13th, 2021.

(EXHIBITS MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.)

ALJ FULLIN: Then you already told me there's also going to be one more Staff (sic)

Exhibit. Do you want to go ahead and introduce that?

MR. McDONNELL: Certainly, your Honor.

There will be -- We will be marking Applicant's

Exhibit 15 which was filed on the docket on

23 October 26th. That is the State Historic

24 Preservation Office's response letter to the History

25 Architecture Study that was filed on October 26th, so

1 earlier this week.

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And if it's okay with you, your Honor, we are happy to call our witness, Sean Flannery.

EVENT HOST: Mr. Flannery, you've been promoted to (inaudible.)

ALJ FULLIN: Okay, I'd like you to raise your right hand to be sworn in.

(Witness placed under oath.)

ALJ FULLIN: Thank you. You can proceed with the examination.

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12 SEAN FLANNERY

being first duly sworn, as prescribed by law, was examined and testified as follows:

15 DIRECT EXAMINATION

16 By Mr. McDonnell:

- Q. Mr. Flannery, can you please state your name, title and company name for the record, please.
- A. Yes, thank you, Sean Flannery, S-E-A-N

 F-L-A-N-N-E-R-Y. I am a Senior Director of

 Permitting and Environmental for Savion, LLC. Savion

 is the owner of the Applicant in this case, Marion

 County Solar Project.
- Q. Thank you, Mr. Flannery. Do you have before you what has been marked as Applicant Exhibit

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- 2 A. Yes, I do.
 - Q. Great. Is that your prefiled testimony that was filed on October 13th, 2021?
 - A. Yes, it is.
 - Q. And can you confirm that that testimony was prepared under your supervision and direction?
 - A. Yes, it was.
 - Q. And do you have any supplements to your testimony?
- A. No, I don't.
- Q. Are you -- Mr. Flannery, are you certain of that, whether you were intending on taking a look at Applicant Exhibit 15 today?
 - A. Yes, apologies. We are offering for the record the Applicant Exhibit 15 that was mentioned earlier.
 - Q. Thank you, Mr. Flannery. And can you -- Would you like to -- Do you have Applicant Exhibit 15 that was filed on October 26th, 2021 in front of you?
 - A. Yes, I do.
- Q. And having already marked that as
 Applicant Exhibit 15, would you like to supplement
 this by adding this particular document to your
 testimony?

A. Yes, I would.

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- Q. Thank you, Mr. Flannery. Do you have any other changes or corrections to your testimony at this time?
 - A. No, I do not.
- Q. Thank you, Mr. Flannery. So if you were asked the same questions that are currently in Applicant Exhibit 14 as supplemented with Applicant Exhibit 15, would your answers be the same?
 - A. Yes, they would.
- Q. Okay. And so do you also have before you what has been marked as Joint Exhibit 1?
 - A. Yes, I do, the Joint Stipulation.
- Q. So can you confirm, is that the Joint Stipulation and Recommendation that was entered into between Marion County Solar Project, the Ohio Power Siting Board Staff and the Ohio Farm Bureau Federation?
 - A. Yes, it is.
 - Q. Thank you, Mr. Flannery.
- MR. McDONNELL: Your Honor, we have no
 further questions for the witness. At this time he's
 available for cross-examination.
- 24 ALJ FULLIN: Thank you. I don't believe 25 I have any questions at this time. Does either the

14 Staff or the Farm Bureau have any questions of this 1 2 witness? Maybe I'll go and take turns. The Farm 3 Bureau first. MS. MILAM: Good morning, your Honor, we 4 5 have no questions for this witness. 6 ALJ FULLIN: Thank you. 7 How about the Staff? 8 MR. LINDGREN: The Staff has no questions 9 either. Thank you. 10 ALJ FULLIN: Thank you. 11 MR. McDONNELL: At this point, your 12 Honor, we would like to move the admission of 13 Applicant's Exhibits 1 through 15 into the record. 14 Thank you. Any objection by ALJ FULLIN: 15 anyone that's of counsel here in the case to the 16 admission of the 15 Exhibits, Staff (sic) Exhibits? 17 MS. MILAM: No objection. 18 MR. LINDGREN: No objections from Staff. 19 ALJ FULLIN: Thank you. I have no 20 objections either. I will admit it into evidence at 2.1 this time. That would be all 15 Exhibits. 2.2 (EXHIBITS ADMITTED INTO EVIDENCE.) 23 MR. McDONNELL: Your Honor, would you 24 also like us to move for the admission of Joint 25 Exhibit 1 or should we wait for the Staff to give

their testimony?

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ALJ FULLIN: I'm fine with doing it that way unless Staff has some reason they prefer to do it differently.

MR. LINDGREN: We have no preference either way, your Honor.

ALJ FULLIN: I will accept that you're offering the Joint Exhibit into evidence at this time. I'm asking either of the parties if they have any objection to admission of Joint Exhibit 1.

MS. MILAM: No objection.

ALJ FULLIN: Hearing no objection, I will admit Joint Exhibit 1 into evidence at this time also.

(EXHIBIT ADMITTED INTO EVIDENCE.)

ALJ FULLIN: Does the Applicant have anything further?

MR. McDONNELL: Nothing further, your
Honor. Thank you.

ALJ FULLIN: Next we'll have testimony from -- I don't know if there's a preference, but I was going to ask the Farm Bureau first if they have anything that they want to present, we'll do that first if they have something.

MS. MILAM: We do not, your Honor.

ALJ FULLIN: Thank you.

Then next I will allow the Staff to put

on their case.

4 MR. LINDGREN: Thank you, your Honor.

5 | The Staff at this time calls Jon Pawley to the stand.

EVENT HOST: Mr. Pawley, you've been

7 promoted.

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ALJ FULLIN: So I'll have you raise your right hand and be sworn in.

10 (Witness placed under oath.)

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12 JON PAWLEY

being first duly sworn, as prescribed by law, was examined and testified as follows:

15 DIRECT EXAMINATION

16 By Mr. Lindgren:

- Q. Good morning, Mr. Pawley. Could you please state your full name for the record.
- A. Yes, my name is Jon Pawley, it's J-O-N
 P-A-W-L-E-Y.
- Q. Thank you. And what is your business address?
- A. My business address is 180 East Broad
 Street, Columbus, Ohio, 43215.
- Q. Thank you. And did you file Prefiled

Testimony in this case on October 20th of 2021?

A. Yes, I did.

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- Q. Thank you. Do you have any changes or corrections to that testimony?
 - A. No, I do not.
- Q. Thank you. Do you have anything to add to that testimony this morning?
 - A. No, sir.
- Q. Thank you. And were you involved in the preparation of the Staff Report in this case?
- A. Yes, I was. In this particular case I served as the overall Staff Project Lead for the investigation, and that resulted in the production of the Staff Report of Investigation that was filed September 13th, 2021.
 - Q. Thank you. Does that report accurately reflect the results of the Staff's investigation?
 - A. Yes, sir.
- MR. LINDGREN: Your Honor, I would ask to have marked as Staff Exhibit 1 the Staff Report and Investigation that was filed in the docket on September 13th of 2021.
- ALJ FULLIN: Your suggestion is that the Staff Report be Staff Exhibit 1?
- MR. LINDGREN: Yes, please.

18 ALJ FULLIN: Yes, it will be so 1 2 identified. 3 MR. LINDGREN: Thank you. (EXHIBIT MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.) 4 5 Q. (By Mr. Lindgren) Mr. Pawley, are you 6 familiar with the terms of the Joint Stipulation and 7 Recommendation? 8 A. Yes, I am. 9 Ο. Thank you. And do you support adoption 10 of the Stipulation by the Board? 11 Yes, Staff supports the adoption by the Α. 12 Board of the Joint Stipulation. 13 MR. LINDGREN: Thank you. I have no 14 further questions. I would ask to have marked as 15 Staff Exhibit 2 the Prefiled Direct Testimony of Jon 16 Pawley that was filed on October 20th, 2021. 17 ALJ FULLIN: Yes, it will be so 18 identified for the record. 19 (EXHIBIT MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.) 20 MR. LINDGREN: Thank you. Subject to any 2.1 cross-examination or questions from the Bench, I move 2.2 for the admission of both Staff Exhibits 1 and 2. 23 ALJ FULLIN: Thank you. Any 24 cross-examination from the Farm Bureau? 25 MS. MILAM: No, your Honor.

ALJ FULLIN: Or from the Applicant?

MR. McDONNELL: No, no questions, your

Honor. Thank you.

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ALJ FULLIN: Okay. I have no cross-examination either, and I've noted that both of the Staff Exhibits have been moved. Any objection to admission of the two Staff Exhibits?

(No Response.)

ALJ FULLIN: Noting there appears to be no objection, those will be admitted into evidence at this time.

(EXHIBITS ADMITTED INTO EVIDENCE.)

ALJ FULLIN: I think we heard from all the parties that are intending to put evidence in the case, so I'm prepared to bring this -- to adjourn this hearing and bring it to a close unless there's anything else that any of the parties need to bring to my attention before I do so.

Noting that there does not seem to be anyone that wants to raise anything else, I will adjourn the hearing at this time, thank everyone for their time as there is nothing further in this case. Thank you.

MS. MILAM: Thank you.

(The hearing was concluded at 10:19 a.m.)
