Instructions for Competitive Retail Natural Gas Service (CRNGS) Providers

- I. Where to file: Applications can be completed and submitted via the PUCO Community. Paper applications, an original plus two copies, can be mailed to: Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, Docketing Division, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus Ohio 43215-3793.
- II. Case Number: If Applicant is applying for any combination of broker and/or aggregator, the application must be filed with an "AGG" purpose code. If the application includes marketer, then the purpose code must be "CRS".
- III. **Renewal applications:** A certificate is valid for two years from the date of issuance. An application for renewal should be filed in the Applicant's existing case number 30-90 days prior to the expiration date printed on the certificate.
- IV. **Confidentiality**: An applicant may file financial statement, forecasted financial statements, financial arrangements, credit ratings, and credit reports under seal. Confidentiality for other items must be requested in a motion filed in the docket. Motions for protective orders must be filed in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code 4901-1-24, 4901:1-27, and 4901:1-24.
- V. **Commission approval process**: The Commission approval process begins when the Commission's Docketing Division receives and time/date stamps the application. An incomplete application may be suspended or rejected. An application that has been suspended an incomplete may cause delay in certification. The Commission may approve, suspend, or deny an application within 30 days. If no action is taken, the application is deemed automatically approved on the 31st day after the official filing date. Upon approval, the Commission will issue a numbered certificate that specifies the service(s) for which the applicant is certified and the dates for which the certificate is valid.
- VI. **Material change**: Providers are required to notify the Commission of any changes to the information provided in its most recent application within thirty days of the change.
- VII. **Governing law**: The certification and renewal of competitive providers is governed by Chapters 4901:1-21, 4901:1-24, 4901:1-27, 4901:1-28, and 4901:1-29 of the Ohio Administrative Code, and Sections 4928.08 and 4929.20 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- VIII. **Questions**: Questions regarding the application should be directed to <u>CRES@puco.ohio.gov</u> or <u>CRNGS@puco.ohio.gov</u>.

Company History

RD Energy, Inc. was founded January 3, 2005. Current owner and President Darrell Bragg bought 100% of RD Energy in July 2008.

Our mission: to provide a resource in this volatile and ever-changing energy market for our customers to rely on for support and guidance in their natural gas and electric purchasing decisions so that those decisions are based on insight and facts supported by the latest market conditions and trends.

Corporate goals:

- 1. Provide information, data, and trends of the energy market so decisions are based on real-time knowledge.
- 2. Provide honest and timely customer advice so buying decisions can be made with confidence.
- 3. Be readily available so customers can feel supported.

Darrell Bragg graduated from college in 1980 with a BS degree with areas of concentration in both accounting and finance. Upon graduation, Darrell went to work for Columbia Gas Transmission for 9 years. The last three years at Columbia Gas Transmissions he worked as a Transportations and Exchange representative providing information, instruction, problem solving and guidance for the new deregulated market, to deregulated customers throughout the Columbia Gas Transmission area. His overall knowledge of accounting, gas measurement, gas control, Appalachian production and billing provided the tools necessary for the Columbia representative position. In 1989 Darrell left Columbia to work over the next six years for two independent natural gas marketers in Ohio. He rose to vice president in both companies exhibiting strength in finance, sales, and sales strategy along with exhibiting strong customer (manufacturing) and Appalachian producer relationships. Darrell joined WPS Energy in 1995 as a Regional Vice President of all customer classes and later headed up the small customer programs (choice) beginning in 1998. In 2000 he started up an agent program that sold gas for WPS Energy and later Integrys Energy to the small choice customers instead of corporate Account Executives. Darrell worked as one of the negotiating regulatory representatives for Integrys Energy as Columbia Gas of Ohio, Dominion East Ohio Gas and Duke Energy worked with the PUCO and interested parties to form the current choice landscape behind each utility.

In July 2008 Darrell left Integrys Energy to take over ownership of RD Energy, Inc. RD Energy's mission statement and corporate goals are the center of Darrell's corporate beliefs and are the foundation of the future vision of the company. In June 2009 RD Energy entered Ohio's electric deregulated market behind the First Energy Utilities in northern Ohio and soon after began serving electric customers behind American Electric Power (AEP).
