- {¶ 1} On April 15, 2020, First Point Power, LLC (First Point) filed its renewable portfolio standard (RPS) annual compliance report for 2019, pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-05.
- {¶ 2} Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-05(D) provides that, if the Commission takes no action with respect to an annual compliance status report within 60 days of the filing of Staff's findings and recommendations, the report is deemed automatically approved on the 61st day after the date filed.
- {¶ 3} Pursuant to its review and recommendation filed on January 5, 2022, Staff alleges First Point did not satisfy its 2019 RPS compliance obligations and that an alternative compliance payment in the amount of \$305.24 is warranted to address its obligations. Staff further requested that this case be suspended. Therefore, the attorney examiner finds that good cause exists to suspend the 60-day automatic approval process for this report, in order to give the Commission time to further review this matter.
