The decision of the UTC will be based solely on the information provided to PUCO Staff for the case file. Please provide all documentation and information that you believe to be important to the case so that the UTC can make a well informed decision. You may attend the UTC meeting when the case is decided; however, you will only be permitted to observe, thus information furnished must have sufficient explanations and stand on its own merits.

If you do not respond by the due date above, your case will still be forwarded to the UTC for a decision. 3781.28(A) - Non-Compliant - No OUPS Ticket

This training shall include excavation near underground facilities, excavation near Interstate and Intrastate pipelines, one call process, mandatory monitoring requirements for pipelines and the dangers associated with damages to underground facilities to include potential impact radius, how to identify release and impact of not reporting damages to facility owners. Sign in sheets required. Respondent shall also complete and submit, within 30 days of notification, a performance improvement plan to include understanding one call obligations and what constitutes excavation in the state of Ohio. Committee reserves the right to seek additional penalties should this corrective action is not completed within the specified timeframe.
