> Notice of Compliance with Certificate Condition #11 - During the construction and operation of the Solar Farm, Hillcrest shall submit to Staff a complaint summary report by the fifteenth day of April, July, October, and December of each year for the first five years of operation. The report should include a list of all complaints received through the Applicant's complaint resolution process, a description of the actions taken toward a resolution of each complaint, and a status update if the complaint has yet to be resolved.

Hillcrest Solar I, LLC ("Hillcrest Solar") is certified to construct a solar-powered electric generation facility in Brown County, Ohio in accordance with the Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (CECPN or Certificate) from the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) on February 15, 2018 (OPSB Case Number: 17-1152-EL-BGN), Order on Certificate on February 21, 2019 (OPSB Case Number 18-1267-EL-BGA) and Construction Notice for the Point of Interconnection/Transmission Line Project on June 21, 2020 (OPSB Case Number: 20-0614-EL-BNR).

In accordance with Certificate Condition #11, a summary of complaints received by Hillcrest Solar I, LLC regarding the Hillcrest Solar Project (the Project) from the second quarter of 2022 (April 1 – June 30) was prepared. Hillcrest Solar received one complaint during this period. This complaint was investigated and determined unlikely to be caused by the Project due to the significant distance from to the individual. The individual that contacted Hillcrest Solar was referred to another electric utility for resolution.

All complaints received by Hillcrest Solar as of July 1, 2022 regarding the Project have been addressed and resolved according to the Complaint Resolution Process as per Certificate Condition #10.

Eliana asked if this was a result of the Hillcrest project and if something could be done about it. JG said that she would take her comment to the team. Eliana stated that she was not angry but wanted to make us aware.

MN called Eliana and let her know that the noises she was hearing/experiencing were likely a result of Duke Energy, and was not a result of Hillcrest due to her distance from Hillcrest. MN suggested that Eliana call Duke and ask for a representative to come to their home so they can witness these noises firsthand. Eliana thanked MN for the call and said she would reach out to Duke Energy.
