The purpose of this filing is to notify the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission") that Dominion Energy Solutions, LLC, f/k/a Dominion Energy Solutions, Inc. ("DES"), will not seek renewal of its certificate to provide competitive retail natural gas services.

The Commission most recently issued Certificate No. 02-018G to DES to provide competitive retail natural gas services. That certificate lapsed on September 11, 2022, and DES did not seek renewal.
