- {¶ 1} On November 29, 2022, New Wave Energy Corp. (New Wave) filed an application to renew its certification as a competitive retail natural gas service (CRNGS) broker.
- {¶ 2} In accordance with R.C. 4929.20 and Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-27-10, New Wave's application is subject to a 30-day automatic approval process. Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-27-10 further provides that, upon good cause shown, the Commission or an attorney examiner may suspend consideration of a certificate application. If an application for certification is suspended, the Commission shall act to approve or deny the application within 90 days of the suspension.
- {¶ 3} The attorney examiner finds that good cause exists to suspend the 30-day automatic approval process with respect to New Wave's renewal application for certification, in order that the Commission and Staff may review the matter further.
