



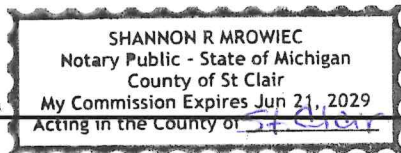

**A-13. Company history**

Foster Energy Services, L.L.C. (FES), a Michigan Limited Liability Company, was formed on December 9, 2004 in response to the deregulation of the natural gas market. FES administers new purchases and nominations, monitors energy deliveries, and reconciles all deliveries and imbalances with local distribution companies.

My Choice Energy L.L.C. (MCE) filed and received certification to provide natural gas retail services in Ohio Case No. 02-2583-GA-CRS. At the time of renewal, the principals of MCE discovered that, unbeknownst to them, the MCE registration in Ohio had been withdrawn. They confronted a variety of issues detailed in the pleadings of case No. 02-2583-GA-CRS and ultimately decided to withdraw from Ohio. MCE at one time had as many as 700 plus Ohio customers in the Duke Ohio service territory. At the time, MCE decided to withdraw from Ohio, the customer numbers were approximately 300. By the time MCE withdrew from Ohio, there were no active contracts. The Ohio customer contracts simply were not renewed. Duke Ohio then became their supplier. The PUCO authorized a procedure for withdrawal. See Entry in Case No. 02-2583-GA-CRS dated August 17, 2005. As far as the Company is aware, the transfer of customers back to Duke Energy Ohio went smoothly.

On September 16, 2021, FES d/b/a My Choice Energy was re-certified (Certificate No. 1-1430E) to provide competitive retail electric services in Ohio Case No. 19-1591-EL-AGG. Currently the Company serves more than 5,000 customers in Michigan and 4,500 customers in Ohio.

As relevant to aggregation services, John Foster is the President and CEO. Rob Archibald is the General Manager of Natural Gas Operations.

The general sales manager and operations manager report to Mr. Archibald. Two customer service representatives report to the general sales manager. Foster has been acting as an Alternative Gas Supplier in the State of Michigan since 2002 and as an Alternative Electric supplier since 2013. Foster d/b/a My Choice Energy has been acting as a Competitive Retail Natural Gas Supplier in the State of Ohio since 2011 and as an Alternative Electric supplier since 2013. 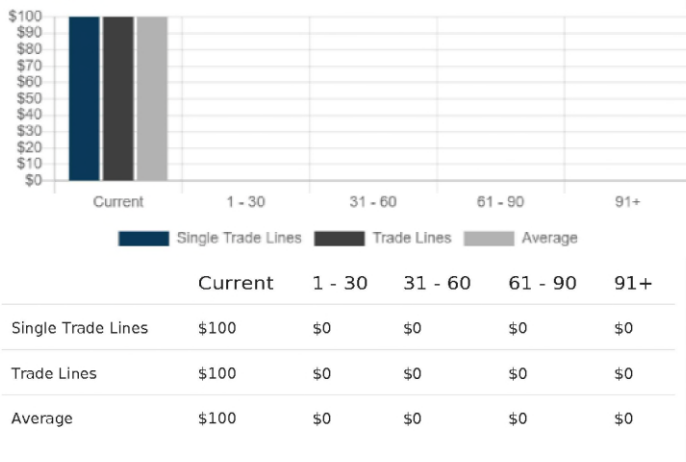

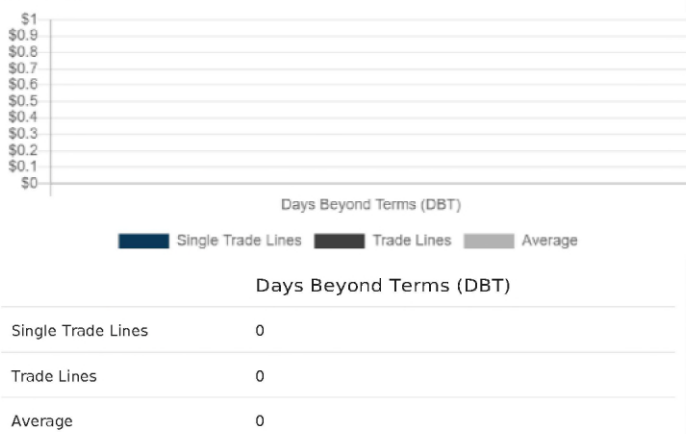

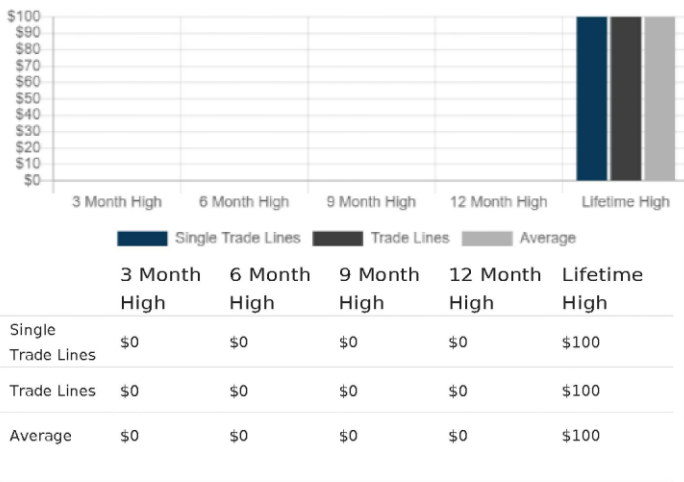

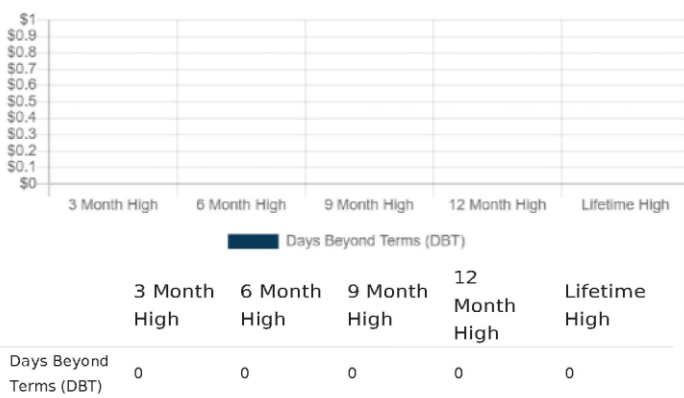

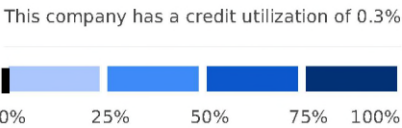
