Power Target, LLC

Case No. 14-1476-EL-AGG

On May 12, 2023, Power Target, LLC (Power Target or Applicant) filed an application with the Commission for certification as a competitive retail electric service (CRES) provider in Ohio. On June 8, 2023, the application was suspended in order to give the Commission and Staff additional time to consider the application.

The application, as filed, did not include all necessary information to determine the financial capability of Power Target to operate as a CRES provider in Ohio. A request was made to Power Target to file additional information. On June 9, 2023, Power Target filed four amendments to the application. After review of the amendments, Staff determined that the application is now incompliance with the requirements for providing CRES in Ohio. Therefore, Staff is recommending that the application filed by Power Target on May 12, 2023, as amended on June 9, 2023, be approved.
