Merger Information: On September 30, 2020, World Fuel Services completed the sale of its Multi Service payment solutions

business ('MSTS') pursuant to the definitive agreement signed on July 30, 2020, for gross cash proceeds

at closing of \$303.5 million (cash proceeds net of post-closing working capital adjustments and cash sold

was \$259.6 million), subject to additional deferred payment of \$75.0 million of which \$50.0 million will

be conditioned on MSTS's achievement of certain financial targets in 2021 and 2022. The contingent

consideration was measured at fair value at the day of the closing. The sale resulted in a pre-tax gain of

\$80.0 million, net of costs to sell, that was included in Other income (expense), net within our Consolidated Statements of Income and Comprehensive Income. The related tax expense of \$12.9

million was included in Provision for income taxes within our Consolidated Statements of Income and

Comprehensive Income. Prior to the sale, MSTS was a reporting unit mainly reported within the land

segment. The sale did not meet the criteria to be reported as a discontinued operation.

During the second quarter of 2020, World Fuel Services acquired an additional interest in a software

company in the aviation segment and obtained control. The transaction was accounted for as an asset

acquisition and did not have a material impact on the Consolidated Financial Statements.



During the first quarter of 2020, World Fuel Services completed the acquisition of the aviation fuel

business from Universal Weather and Aviation, Inc. ('UVair fuel business'), which serves business and

general aviation customers worldwide. The acquisition was accounted for as a business combination.

No material acquisitions or divestitures occurred during 2019.
