(A) Government Emergency Telecommunications Service (GETS) (Cont'd)

(3) GETS Egress Queuing (EQ)

GETS EQ is a switch-based feature that provides priority call processing to calls designated as HPC that are terminating on a designated PBX trunk group. GETS EQ extends the functionality of the existing GETS HPC feature to include two way and Primary Rate ISDN which connects a DMS to a PBX.

This feature is available on DMS100 switches with release NA012.

(a) GETS EQ Nonrecurring Charges

(1) GETS EQ Service Preparation Charge

A nonrecurring charge for GETS EQ that will be charged for the initial service preparation.

(2) GETS EQ Charge Per Switch

A nonrecurring charge per switch for initial upgrades that will be charged for activation of the EQ feature in the DMS100 switches.

(b) Recurring Charges

GETS EQ Recurring Charge Per Switch

A monthly recurring charge that will be charged per switch for the GETS EQ feature.
