- (1) The cause of these complaints was the excessive growth of weeds and vegetation at various locations along respondents' tracks in the state of Ohio.
- (2) The Commission's railroad staff has filed reports in these cases. In the reports, staff stated that corrective action taken by the railroad, in the form of cutting weeds and vegetation, has eliminated cause for those complaints. Staff recommended that these cases be closed.

It is, therefore,


