
## Interconnection Agreements

## 3.9.1 Calling Party Number Blocking (Cont'd)

Per Line Calling Party Number Blocking automatically prevents the display of the calling telephone number on all calls dialed from an exchange service equipped with this option. It is not necessary to dial an activation code prior to placing the call.

No business, organization or other person may use Calling Party Number Blocking where the primary purpose is to make telephone solicitation calls. The term "telephone solicitation" means the initiation of a telephone message primarily for the purpose of encouraging a person to purchase, rent, or invest in property, goods, or services or to donate to any charity or similar organization or entity without that person's prior express invitation or permission.

#### 3.9.2 Caller ID

Caller ID allows a customer to identify the telephone number from which a call is being made. The telephone number of the person initiating the call is displayed on a customer-provided display device. The customer-provided display device must conform with the Company's Technical References.

Caller ID is offered in appropriately equipped central offices.

## 3.9.3 Caller ID With Name

Caller ID with Name works along with Caller ID and provides for the display of an incoming telephone number and listed name associated with that telephone number, on a customer-provided display device attached to the customer's (called party's) line or set. The customer-provided display device used to interface with Caller ID and Caller ID with Name must conform with the Company's Technical Reference Specifications.

Unless Calling Party Number Blocking is activated, the telephone numbers and names associated with all calls originating from appropriately equipped switches will be displayed.



#### 3.9.1 Calling Party Number Blocking (Cont'd)

Per Line Calling Party Number Blocking automatically prevents the display of the calling telephone number on all calls dialed from an exchange service equipped with this option. It is not necessary to dial an activation code prior to placing the call. Calls may be unblocked on a per occurrence basis by dialing an activation code.

No business, organization or other person may use Calling Party Number Blocking where the primary purpose is to make telephone solicitation calls. The term "telephone solicitation" means the initiation of a telephone message primarily for the purpose of encouraging a person to purchase, rent, or invest in property, goods, or services or to donate to any charity or similar organization or entity without that person's prior express invitation or permission.

#### 3.9.2 Caller ID

Caller ID allows a customer to identify the telephone number from which a call is being made. The telephone number of the person initiating the call is displayed on a customer-provided display device. The customer-provided display device must conform with the Company's Technical References. Caller ID is offered in appropriately equipped central offices.

#### 3.9.3 Caller ID With Name

Caller ID with Name works along with Caller ID and provides for the display of an incoming telephone number and listed name associated with that telephone number, on a customer-provided display device attached to the customer's (called party's) line or set. The customer-provided display device used to interface with Caller ID and Caller ID with Name must conform with the Company's Technical Reference Specifications.

Unless Calling Party Number Blocking is activated, the telephone numbers and names associated with all calls originating from appropriately equipped switches will be displayed.

Caller ID with Name is offered in appropriately equipped central offices.

#### 3.9.4 Call Return

This custom feature enables a customer to place a call to the telephone number associated with the most recent call received. whether or not the call was answered. The customer can dial a code (\*69) and the number from which the last incoming call that was placed is announced/displayed. The call will not be returned, announced, or displayed if it is marked private through the activation of per call or per line number privacy. If the customer wishes to return the call, a code is dialed to place the call. If the called line is not busy, the call is placed. If the called line is busy. a confirmation announcement is heard, the customer hangs up and a queuing process begins where both the originating and terminating lines are checked for a period of thirty minutes for availability to complete the call. During this process, if the called line becomes available, the originating customer is notified by a distinctive ring that the network is ready to place the call. When the customer picks up the telephone, the call will automatically be placed.

Call Return does not interfere with the normal operation of incoming and outgoing calls during the queuing process. Call Return is considered activated when the customer dials the first code. The Call Return customer is responsible for any applicable local or toll usage charges for returned calls. The service cannot be activated for all telephone numbers, for example, 700, 800, or 900 numbers.

Description of and Rationale for the Proposed Tariff Change:

In this application, Buckeye TeleSystem is amending its tariff to add Call Return, a custom feature that enables a customer to place a call to the telephone number associated with the most recent call received, whether or not the call was answered. The customer can dial a code to display the number from which the last incoming call that was placed is announced/displayed. Entering a second code enables the customer to dial automatically that number, and if busy, to keep trying for a specified period until the number can be connected. The call will not be returned, announced, or displayed if it is marked private through the activation of per call or per line number privacy. This is a switched service. The additional service is offered to business customers of the Company.

#### REVISED NOTICE FOR NEWSPAPER

Buckeye TeleSystem, Inc. ("Buckeye") has filed with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, changes in its Tariff No. 2 on file with the Commission. The Company is amending its tariff to add Call Return, a custom feature that enables a customer to place a call to the telephone number associated with the most recent call received, whether or not the call was answered. The customer can dial a code to display the number from which the last incoming call that was placed is announced/displayed. Entering a second code enable the customer to dial automatically that number, and if busy, to keep trying for a specified period until the number can be connected. The call will not be returned, announced, or displayed if it is marked "private" through the activation of per call or per line number privacy. A customer may subscribe to unlimited Call Return and pay a flat monthly charge of \$4.00 and not be charged on a per occurrence basis or may pay no monthly flat charge and pay \$.75 for each occurrence or use of Call Return.

Buckeye is also proposing two additional services relating to the blocking and unblocking of calls. Currently, customers may block the identification of calls to third parties with Caller I.D. by dialing an activation code prior to placing the call. There is no charge for this service. Buckeye is proposing a charge of \$3.00 per line per month for Caller I.D. Blocking which would enable customers to automatically block the identity of the caller without having to dial an activation code. Buckeye also proposes to enable customers who have Caller I.D. Blocking to be able to "unblock" certain calls by dialing an activation code prior to making the call. Such unblocking will be charged at \$.75 per occurrence.

All changes affect business customers.
