ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On January 5, 1996, a vehicle operated by Arctic Express, Inc. (Arctic) and driven by Randolph M. Smith was inspected by staff and an apparent false log book entry in violation of Rule 4901:2-7-07, Ohio Administrative Code, was noted.
- (2) By entry of December 5, 1996, this matter was set for prehearing on December 17, 1996 and hearing on February 11, 1997.
- (3) On December 20, 1996, staff and Arctic docketed a letter in this matter. The letter states that staff no longer seeks to pursue this matter as Arctic agrees that for purposes of settlement the violation occurred and Arctic agrees that the violation may be included in the carrier's history of violations.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the settlement agreement filed by staff and Arctic Express, Inc. in this case is approved and adopted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That this case is closed as a matter of record. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
