- (1) This complaint case was filed on September 21, 2001. In the complaint, Jodie McIntosh (complainant) stated that, for the billing period of March/April 2001, she received a gas bill of \$855.53 from The East Ohio Gas Company, dba Dominion East Ohio, and that this bill was disproportionate to her actual gas usage. Further, complainant requested that respondent adjust her bill to reflect her actual gas usage.
- (2) On October 10, 2001, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint. In the motion, the parties stated that they have settled this matter and have resolved all of the issues raised in the complaint.
- (3) In view of the settlement of the dispute between the parties, this complaint should be dismissed.
