ENTRY

The attorney examiner, pursuant to the authority granted in Rule 4901-1-14, Ohio Administrative Code, finds:

- (1) On December 2, 2002, Mr. Steven C. Barnes (Complainant) filed a formal complaint with the Commission against McLeod USA (Respondent) alleging that Respondent had improperly billed charges to four phone lines maintained by his businesses and had not provided proper service for his businesses.
- (2) On December 24, 2002 Respondent filed its answer stating that it had disconnected three of the four lines involved here pursuant to the Complainant's request and credited him for all pending balances. Respondent states it has no record of service complaints with the remaining line. Respondent states it has not failed to perform any obligations to the Complainant and requests the complaint be dismissed with prejudice.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that this matter should be set for a settlement conference on January 30, 2003, at 10:00 a.m., in the Legal Department Conference Room, Room 1252, 12th floor of the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793. The purpose of the settlement conference will be to determine whether this matter can be informally resolved.
