Dear Ms. Crockron:

Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company (CBT) proposes to revise its Out of Territory Services Tariff PUCO No. 1 to provide a special promotion of its *pay-per-use* services to *residential* customers. The *pay-per-use* services include *Three-Way Calling, Call Return, and Repeat Dialing Services*. CBT will waive the \$.95 per usage charge normally associated with the *pay-per-use* services during the promotion period which will be Christmas Day, December 25, 2000.
