On October 10, 2003, SBC Ohio filed an application in the above cases to revise an earlier filing that established the general terms & conditions associated with a disaster plan. SBC Ohio has been asked by the Staff of the PUCO to resubmit its October 10th filing using an "ATA" purpose code to replace the original "ZTA" code. This change will also cause the effective date of this tariff to become November 10, 2003. 6. INFORMATIONAL NOTICE

6.1 Landline Direct-Dialed Calls

Landline direct-dialed calls made by the customer to certain cellular or paging telephone numbers may incur an additional charge. This charge is assessed by the wireless provider, not by SBC Ohio.

7. DISASTER PLAN

When a business or residence customer's premise is destroyed or partially destroyed by means beyond the control of the customer, i.e., natural disaster or fire, the following emergency plan will go into effect:

- The service connection charge to re-establish the local exchange access line after the disaster will be waived. (C)
- The monthly rate and associated Service Connection Charge will be waived for thirty days for the following services:
 - Call Forwarding
 - Call Forward Busy Line
 - Call Forward Don't Answer
 - Remote Call Forward
 - Message Waiting Indicator
