

SUPPLEMENT TO APPLICATION

The Dayton Power and Light Company ("DP&L"), Applicant herein, is an Ohio corporation engaged in the business of generating and delivering electric energy to consumers in Ohio. As such, DP&L is a public utility as defined by Sections 4905.02 and 4905.03 of the Ohio Revised Code and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (the "Commission"). DP&L filed its original Application in this proceeding on September 2, 2005. Some of the rates in Schedule 4 in the original filing were not accurately reflected in the proposed Storm Cost Recovery Rider, Sheet No. D36. DP&L hereby requests the proposed The Storm Cost Recovery Rider, Electric Distribution Service, Original Sheet No. D36, attached as Exhibit 1, replace the Storm Cost Recovery Rider originally filed in the above captioned case.

DP&L respectfully requests the Commission to approve the Application as supplemented by this filing for DP&L's request to recover costs associated with ice storms in December 2004 and January 2005.
