Dear Ms. Crockron:

Enclosed please find an original and seven (7) copies of the Company's Telecommunications Application Form ("Application") requesting approval for change in operations by a non-LEC provider. With this Application, the Company requests the PUCO's approval of the Company's name change. With this letter, the Company also informs the Commission that, effective immediately, its address has changed to 1010 West Washington Street, Marquette, Michigan, 49855.

The PUCO approved the Company's application for authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service on October 16, 2002, Certificate No. 90-6085. In preparing its paperwork for the Ohio Secretary of State to become qualified as a foreign corporation, the Company inadvertently registered itself with three corporate names, rather than one corporate name and two fictitious names. The Company learned of its mistake in January 2004 while reviewing annual report forms due the Ohio Secretary of State. As a result, the Company refiled forms with the Ohio Secretary of State registering itself with the corporate name of Superior Spectrum Michigan¹ and registering three fictitious names: FSG Long Distance, Superior

¹ The Company's actual corporate name, Superior Technologies, Inc., (or a name substantially similar), was already in use at the time the Company initially made application to the Ohio Secretary of State.

Spectrum and WPS Communications. Since beginning service in Ohio, the Company had been billing its customers under the name FSG Long Distance. Upon settling its corporate/trade name status with the Ohio Secretary of State, the Company notified its Ohio customers of its name change to WPS Communications via bill insert on April 30 and May 3, 2004.

The Company has provided the following exhibits in support of its Application:

- A. Copies of new tariff title page and check sheet reflecting name change.
- B. Certification from the Ohio Secretary of State indicating corporate and fictitious names currently registered.
- C. Affidavit attesting that customer notice has been given and a copy of the real time notice that has been provided to Customers.
