ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On May 31, 2006, Akim M. Rahman filed a complaint against Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. (Columbia), alleging that Columbia improperly billed him for gas services.
- (2) On June 20, 2006, Columbia filed an answer, denying the allegations in the complaint.
- (3) On September 12, 2006, Columbia filed a motion to dismiss, together with a memorandum in support. Columbia states that the parties have agreed upon a settlement to resolve all of the issues in the complaint.
- (4) Rule 4901-9-01(E), Ohio Administrative Code, provides that, when a public utility files a motion stating that the case has been settled, the complainant shall file a response within 20 days. If no response is filed, the Commission may presume that settlement has occurred and may dismiss the complaint.
- (5) The complainant in this case has filed no response to Columbia's motion to dismiss. Therefore, the Commission presumes that the case is settled and that, in light of the resolution of the complaint, this case should be dismissed and closed of record.




ORDERED, That Case No. 06-754-GA-CSS be dismissed and closed of record. It is, further,






