The Attorney Examiner finds:


- (1) On March 17, 2000, the Ohio Edison Company, Pennsylvania Power Company, Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company and the Toledo Edison Company (hereinafter FirstEnergy) filed a motion for extension of time to file its long term forecast report until 45 days following the issuance of the Commission's new long term forecast rules in Case No. 99-1614-EL-ORD.
- (2) On April 6, 2000, the Commission issued its Finding and Order and attached rules in Case No. 99-1614-EL-ORD.
- (3) FirstEnergy's request for an extension of time is granted until May 22, 2000.

ORDERED, That FirstEnergy's request for an extension of time to file its long term forecast report is granted until May 22, 2000. It is, further,


