The Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) granted a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the subject project on September 20, 1993. One of the certificate conditions ordered that Ohio Edison shall provide to the Staff the date on which construction was completed and the date on which the facility began commercial operation.

The construction for the Crissinger-Roberts portion of the subject project was completed and placed in service on April 8, 1996. Construction for the Kirby-Roberts portion of the subject project was completed and placed in service on May 8, 1996. The Kirby 138-69 kV Substation construction was completed on April 15, 1996. The 138 kV bus equipment and the 138-69 kV transformer at Kirby Substation were placed in service on May 8, 1995. The 69 kV portion of Kirby will be energized upon completion of remaining 69 kV transmission line work.
