The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On June 22, 2004, Ms. Leisa Dickerson (complainant) filed a complaint with the Commission against The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company. The complainant alleges that a power surge damaged appliances in her home.
- (2) On August 12, 2004, a settlement conference was held in an attempt to informally resolve this matter. The parties were unable to reach a resolution of the issue presented in the complaint. Further, it appears that reasonable grounds for complaint have been presented. As a result, this case should now be scheduled for hearing.


