Name Change

Dear Sir or Madam:

Williams Communications, LLC ("WCL") plans to change its name to WilTel Communications, LLC effective January 29, 2003.

We are also pleased to announce that WCL's parent corporation has emerged from Chapter 11 bankruptcy. WCL itself was not part of these bankruptcy proceedings and the proceedings did not affect WCL's provision of service to the public.

A plan of reorganization for Williams Communications Group, Inc., confirmed by the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York on September 30, 2002, ³¹ provided for the creation of WilTel Communications Group, Inc. ("WilTel Group"), a new holding company, and the transfer of ownership of WCL from Williams Communications Group, Inc. to WilTel Group. WilTel Group is incorporated in Nevada.

One of the agreements reached in conjunction with the reorganization plan obligates WilTel Group, WCL, and their affiliates to cease using "Williams" as part of their names. Because a highly regarded predecessor company used the "WilTel" name, we have decided to bring back that name as part of WilTel Group's emergence from bankruptcy. We will, of course, make required changes to WCL's tariffs.

³¹ Williams Communications Group, Inc. (the former holding company of WCL) filed a voluntary petition for bankruptcy under Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code on April 22, 2002. Its Plan of Reorganization became effective October 16, 2002 at 12:00a.m.
