The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) On January 22, 2001, Nick G. Verikakis filed a complaint against Ameritech, Ohio (Ameritech) alleging that his telephone service from Ameritech was inadequate due to service transfer problems.
- (2) Due to the Commission's stated goal of reducing the number of adversarial proceedings before it, this matter should be scheduled for a prehearing settlement conference at 10:00 a.m., on February 28, 2001, in Hearing Room 11-F, at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. The purpose of the conference is to determine whether this matter can be resolved informally. In the event that a settlement is not reached, the attorney examiner will conduct a discussion of procedural issues at the conclusion of the conference.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That a prehearing settlement conference be held as set forth in Finding (2). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.




