ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On January 6, 2005, the City of Cleveland filed a complaint against SBC Ohio (SBC). In its complaint, the City of Cleveland claims entitlement to a refund for billing errors relating to 13 telecommunications circuits. Through its complaint, the City of Cleveland seeks to recover a refund and interest in the amount of \$759,367.
- (2) On January 19, 2005, the attorney examiner issued an entry scheduling this case for a 30-day period in which to conduct mediation. Pending mediation, the attorney examiner suspended SBC's obligation to file an answer. With the consent of the parties, mediation shall be extended for an additional 30-day period. The extended 30-day period for mediation shall begin on the date of this entry.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the 30-day period for mediation shall be extended for an additional 30 days, beginning on the date of this entry. It is, further,

ORDERED, That SBC's obligation to file an answer to the complaint shall remain suspended until 20 days following the conclusion of mediation. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party and all interested persons of record.
