In your comments prior to construction of our gas transmission line, you asked that Cincinnati Gas & Electric Co. arrange for the organization and analysis of data that has been collected in the Turpin region of Hamilton County. You also asked that we prepare a public display of the archaeologic significant of the project area. The Ohio Power Siting Board included those requests in their letter to us that granted approval to build the line. In cooperation with Gray & Pape, Inc. and the Cincinnati Museum Center, we have completed that final step of compliance with your office and the OPSB.

Last night we presented the Anderson Township Trustees with three copies of a three panel, table-top display that measures approximately 72" by 36". A reduced scale copy is enclosed with this letter to you. The displays were dry mounted to foamcore and will be for the use of the township however they see fit.

The Trustees and their staff were quite pleased to receive the displays and they are already making plans to incorporate them into school curricula. Kevin Pape also offered the assistance of his office to township staff who are coordinating use of the displays.

We feel that the option to prepare the data analysis report and this display instead of undertaking traditional excavation and recovery mitigation was a very positive step on the part of your office. I imagine that Dr. Orloff Miller's report that we sent to you office several months ago will be a standard reference for many years in the future, and based on the feedback from the township staff, the displays will see a great deal of use. Thank you for the opportunity to help us keep this project on track and budget, and also provide archaeologic educational benefits to the lay public.
