
Dear Chairman Schriber,







I am a resident in Parkman and like to have this modern convenience of natural gas service to my home. I believe there are many people in the community who are interested in this service.

Many residents have changed their lifestyles to prepare for this service. My father-in-law, for example, heated his home with wood and a coal furnace for nearly 50 years, and when this service was offered, he removed his coal furnace and bought a gas furnace. With all the time delays during this project, the weather turned cold and he had to hire the installer again to change items on the furnace and contact a propane supplier so he could have heat in his house. This man is 70 years old and is ill. He should not have had to go through this upsetting process.

Mr. Ed Bonk, who has been my communications person throughout this whole ordeal, has been very helpful with information concerning this project. It is my opinion that this person is willing to work with the community to get this project completed to the township's satisfaction. He seems to be knowledgeable about the project and the gas industry.
