# **ENTRY**

The attorney examiner finds:

(1) The Ohio General Assembly has passed, and the Governor signed, legislation that requires the restructuring of the electric industry and provides for retail competition concerning

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the generation component of electric service (Amended Sub. Senate Bill 3 of the 123rd General Assembly). Section 4928.31, Revised Code, requires each electric utility to file with the Commission a transition plan for the utility's provision of retail electric service in the state of Ohio.

- (2) The Cincinnati Gas and Electric Company, The Dayton Power and Light Company, American Electric Power (on behalf of Ohio Power Company and Columbus Southern Power Company), Monongahela Power Company, and FirstEnergy Corp. (on behalf of Ohio Edison Company, The Toledo Edison Company, and The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company), hereinafter referred to as the utilities, have filed applications for approval of electric transition plans.
- (3) Pursuant to recently adopted rules, the Commission has scheduled public hearings on each of the utilities' transition plan applications. The Commission also wishes to hold local public hearings in each of the utilities' service territories to provide the public the opportunity to comment on the transition plans for the utilities' provision of retail electric service in the state of Ohio.
- (4) Accordingly, the Commission will hold local public hearings on the following transition plan applications at the times and places set forth below:
