ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On October 6, 2005, Joseph Robert Grenga dba Grenga Machine and Welding (Grenge) filed a complaint against Ohio Edison Company (Ohio Edison) and First Energy Solutions, Corp. (FES) alleging that Ohio Edison and FES improperly disconnected the electric service to Grenga's facilities, improperly charged a late payment fee on the account, and required the payment of an excessive amount for service in order to have the electric service reconnected. Grenga also alleges that the disconnection was in retaliation for a different complaint regarding a different facility. Grenga alleges damages caused by the disconnection.
- (2) Ohio Edison is a public utility and an electric light company pursuant to Sections 4905.02 and 4905.03, Revised Code, and is therefore, subject to Commission jurisdiction under Sections 4905.04, 4905.05 and 4905.06, Revised Code. FES is a competitive retail electric service provider, certified by the Commission pursuant to Chapter 4928, Revised Code, and is therefore, subject to Commission jurisdiction.
- (3) On January 19, 2006, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the case, stating that the parties have reached an informal settlement that fully and finally resolves all issues in this proceeding. The joint motion is signed by all parties. The

parties request that the pending complaint case be dismissed with prejudice.




- (4) Under the circumstances, the parties' request that the complaint case be dismissed with prejudice is reasonable and should be granted.
