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

## Exhibit A-15 Corporate Structure



#### Exhibit A-16 Company History

Border Energy, Inc. was formed in August 2003 by Steve Casciani. Border Energy Inc. served for 7 years solely as a Natural Gas marketing company. From August 2003 to June 2009 Border Energy, Inc. participated exclusively in the NIPSCO service territory. In that period Border Energy, Inc. grew from a non-existent customer base to more than 15,000 customers. In 2009 Border Energy, Inc. entered natural gas markets located in both Ohio and Michigan and continued to grow. In 2010 the principal owners of Border Energy, Inc. applied for a CRES license under the name Border Energy Electric Services, Inc. That license was granted and the two companies operated separately and independent through 2011. In late 2011, the principal owners of both companies completed a corporate restructuring that created Border Energy Gas Services, Inc., and Border Energy Electric Services, Inc. as independent companies wholly owned by parent company Border Energy, Inc. (See graphical representation in appendix A-15).

Border Energy Gas Services, Inc. (BEGS) specializes in the purchasing, transportation and risk management and sale of natural gas supplies primarily to this residential and small commercial customers behind Columbia Gas of Ohio in Ohio, Northern Indiana Public Service Co (NIPSCO) in Indiana, and Consumers Energy, DTE MichCon, Semco and Michigan Gas Utilities (MGU) in Michigan. In total, BEGS serves approximately 20,000 residential and small commercial customers in these service territories.

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
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


